

Eligibility Criteria

National Title I Distinguished Schools Recognition Program 2007-2008

Criteria for Category 1: Exceptional Student Performance for two or more consecutive years:

- campus is designated as a Title I, Part A campus for 2005-2006, 2006-2007 and 2007-2008;
- campus poverty level is 40% or greater in 2007-2008;
- campus meets AYP in 2007, 2006;
- campus is Exemplary in Spring 2007;
- campus is Exemplary in Spring 2006 and greater than or equal to 50% Commended Performance in reading and math
- campus is Exemplary for Spring 2005.

Criteria for Category 2: Closing the Achievement Gap between student groups:

- campus is designated as a Title I, Part A campus for 2005-2006, 2006-2007 and 2007-2008;
- campus poverty level is 40% or greater in 2007-2008;
- campus meets AYP in 2007, 2006;
- campus is Exemplary in Spring 2007;
- campus is Exemplary or Recognized in Spring 2006 and greater than or equal to 37% Commended Performance in reading and math;
- campus is Academically Unacceptable or Academically Acceptable in Spring 2005.
