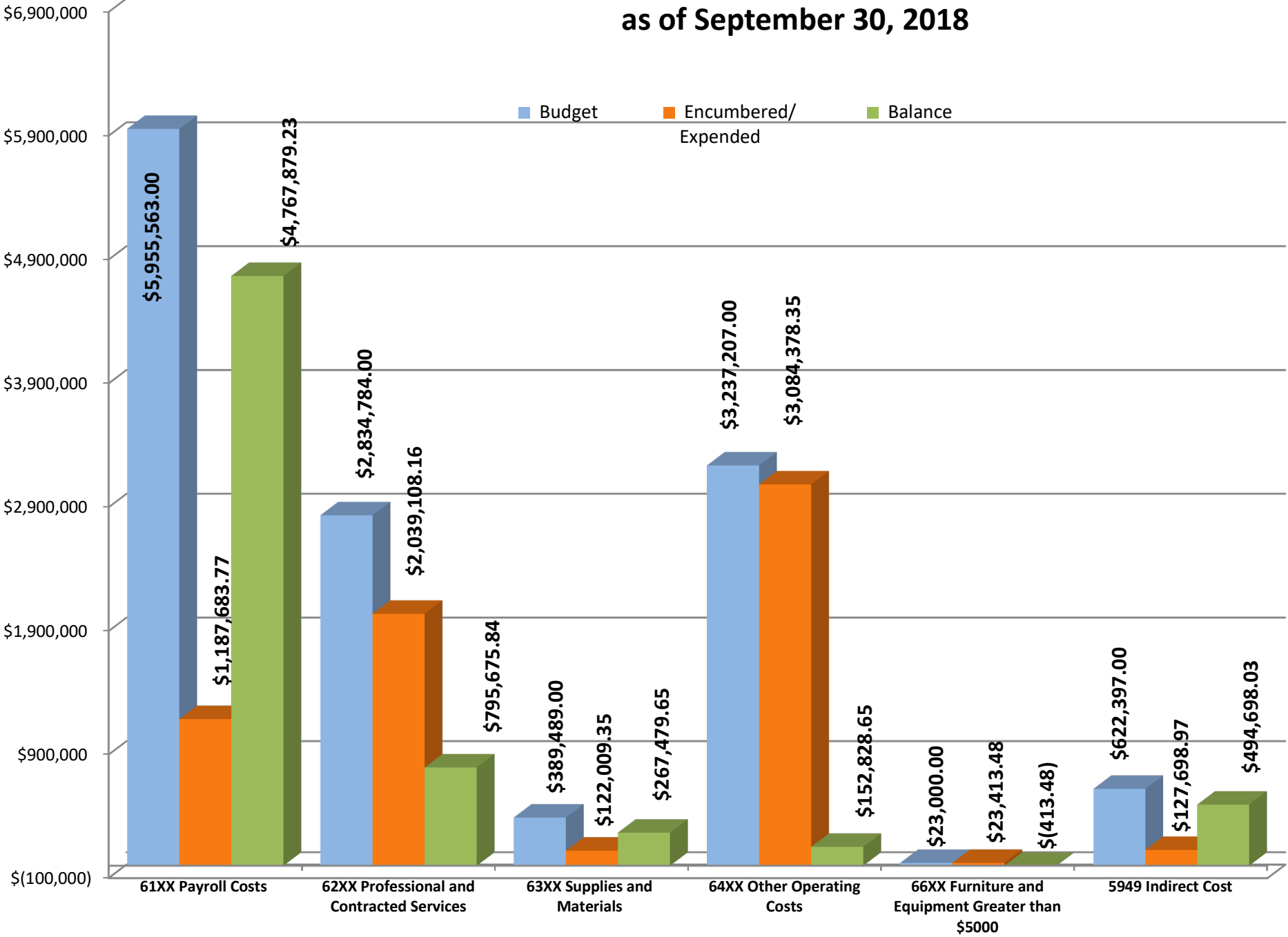


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

Early Head Start Education: Conducted Class Assessment Scoring System Observation Reliability training for 13 directors, codirectors, and mentor staff; completed read aloud program session for 7 families; conducted Creative Curriculum, Teaching Strategies Gold Assessment, and Conscious Discipline Safe Place training for 32 new teachers.		
Head Start Education: Conducted Class Assessment Scoring System training for 9 new regional Head Start teachers; conducted training for 11 new instructional regional assistants; conducted training on learning centers and challenging behaviors for 9 second year teachers; began Children’s Learning Institute Assessments and Brigance screenings in all 66 Head Start classrooms.		
Family Services: Family Services Assistants and Home Educators initiated Family Partnership Agreement with all families; presented Conscious Discipline Composure at 22 Head Start sites (to 242 parents); facilitated 5 sessions of Parent Leadership Training totaling 20 parents and 31 staff.		
Health: Conducted 45-day screenings for 15 sites and 45-day dental clinics for 9 sites; 90-day screenings for 3 sites; 1517 students served; attended West Texas Health Managers and Networking for Kids meeting.		
Mental Wellness: Attended Training of Trainers for Pyramid Model; attended Region VI Mental Health component training; attended Training of Trainers for Georgetown Mental Health Consultation model training; provided Conscious Discipline training for 13 parents at Canyon.		
Nutrition: Completed initial height and weight screening for 935 Head Start and 61 Early Head Start children; monitored Cleveland and Nelson Centers for Child and Adult Care Food Program compliance.
