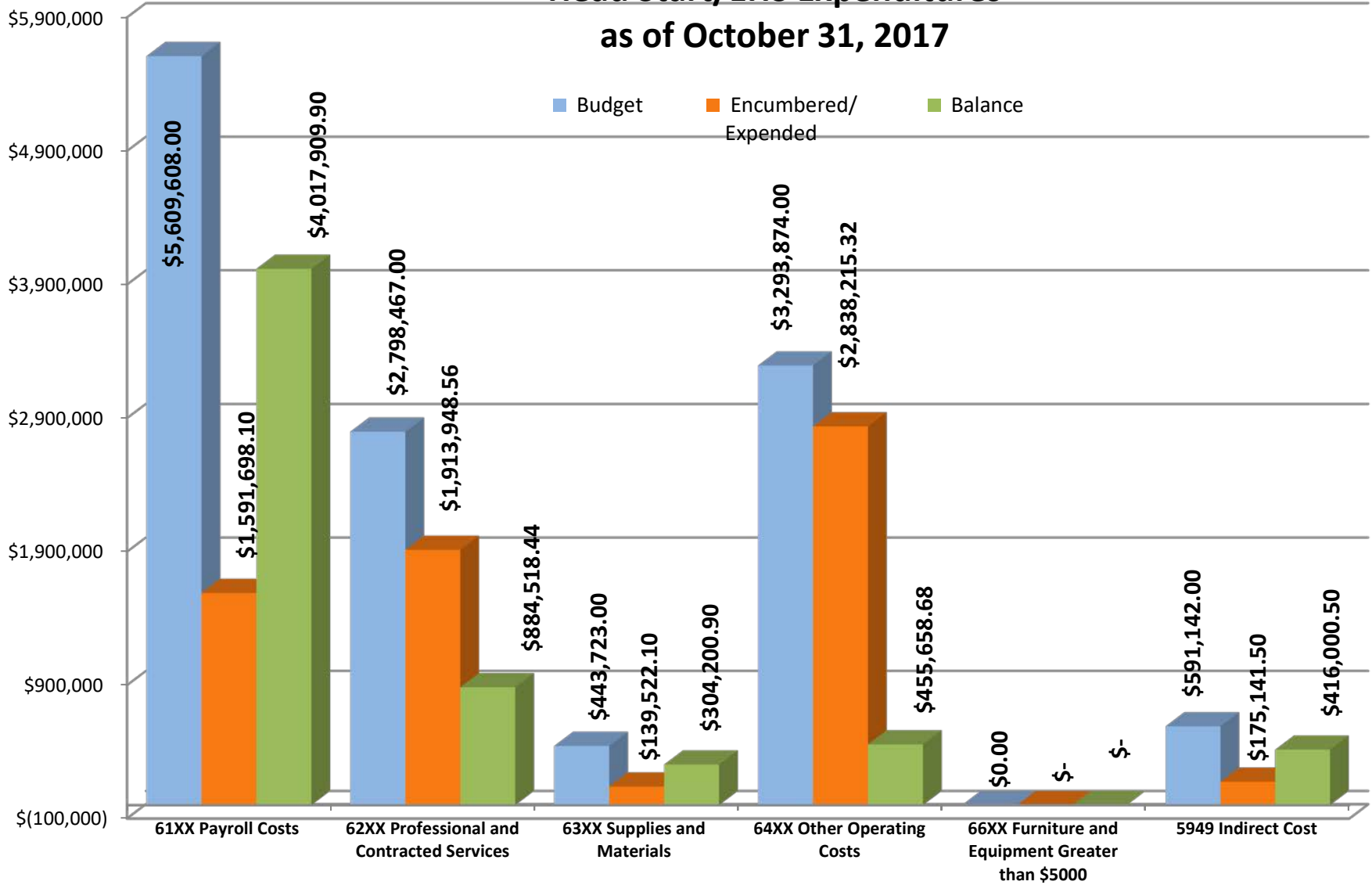


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<p><i>Head Start Education:</i> Conducted New Teacher Academy training for 14 teachers; conducted second Teacher Academy training for 8 Head Start teachers; all Head Start teachers completed the Brigance screening; 2 administrators trained to be Classroom Assessment Scoring System observers; 4 Head Start teachers trained in the Classroom Assessment Scoring system; 62 Head Start teachers began entering child assessment data into Children’s Learning Institute Engage.</p>		
<p><i>Early Head Start Education:</i> Completed assessment data checkpoints for 268 enrolled Early Head Start children; completed Child Development & Behavior Training for 8 Early Head Start teachers; completed Curriculum & Assessment training for 12 Early Head Start teachers.</p>		
<p><i>Family Services:</i> Conducted elections to select 12 parent representatives for Policy Council; facilitated first Policy Council meeting with 13 representatives in attendance; attended Pennal Mental Health lecture to improve suicide symptom awareness for 11 Family Service staff.</p>		
<p><i>Health:</i> Completed 90 day screenings approximately on 375 Head Start and Early Head Start students; organized dental clinic with Dr. Kemp, Dr. DeVries, and Dr. Haney screening approximately 300 students; completed home-visit for 3 pregnant mom/newborn.</p>		
<p><i>Mental Wellness:</i> Conducted site visits for all sites; began reviewing completion rates and results of social-emotional-behavioral screenings for enrolled students.</p>		
<p><i>Nutrition:</i> Completed growth assessments for 164 Head Start/56 Early Head Start children; coordinated Head Start Family Fair with 27 community agencies/serving 241 Head Start/Early Head Start families; provided Child and Adult Care Food Program annual training for 7 kitchen staff members and 4 administrative staff members.</p>
