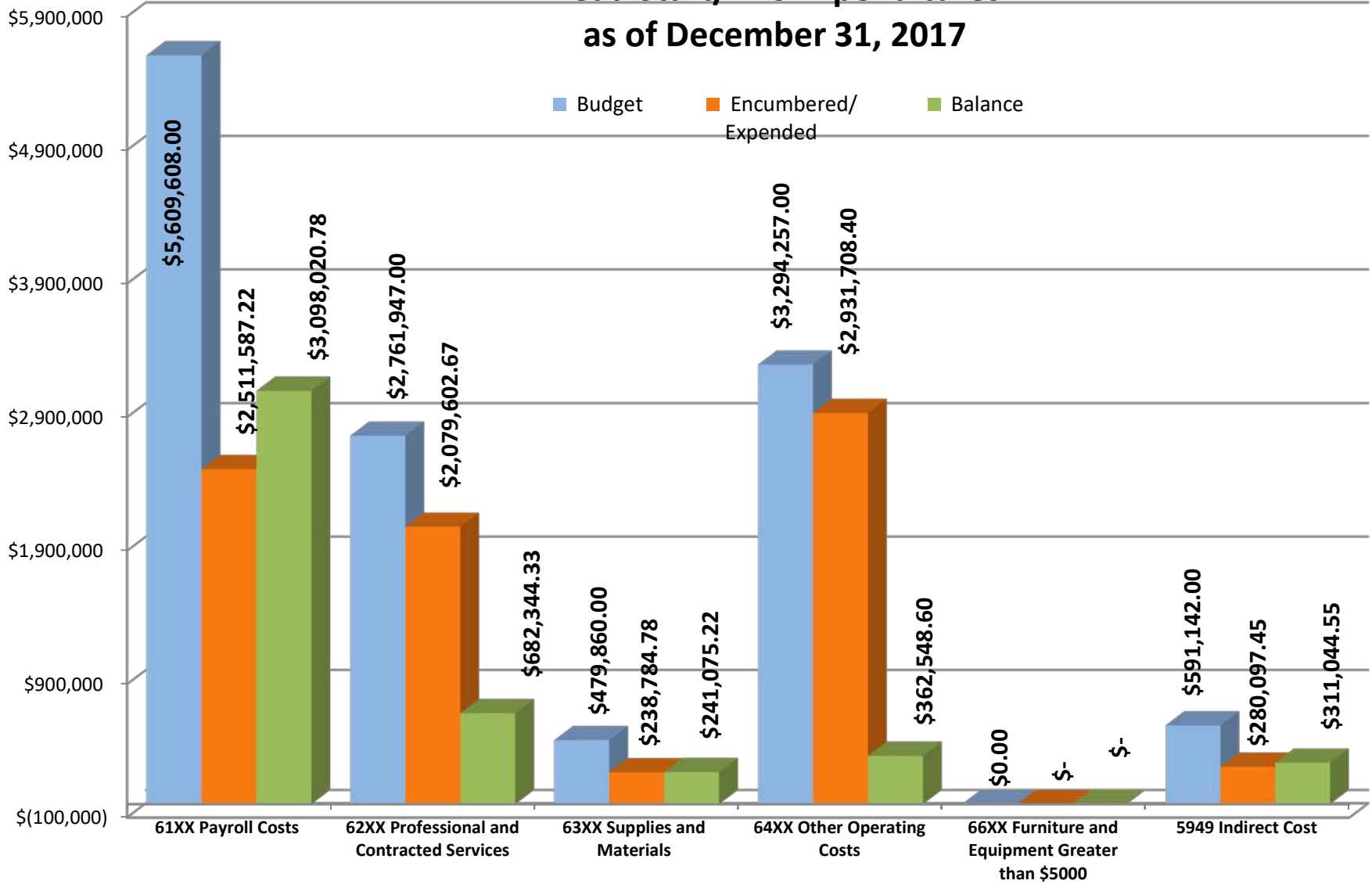


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Early Head Start Education:</i> Attended Conscious Discipline training-34 teachers; attended an Early Head Start Comprehensive services training-14 Family Service Assistants and Early Head Start staff; completed 14 Infant/Toddler Environmental Rating Scale evaluations.		
<i>Head Start Education:</i> Completed 62 Classroom Assessment Scoring System observations; conducted mock interviews for Federal Monitoring all teachers and instructional assistants at Nelson and Cleveland centers; conducted Professional Learning Communities for teachers in Pampa, Perryton, and Dumas; provided Teacher Learning Communities for teachers in Farwell, Hereford, Bovina, Friona, Dimmitt, Hart, Childress, and Wellington.		
<i>Family Services:</i> Provided holiday assistance to 60 families in the region; attended the National Head Start Association Parent & Family Engagement Conference 2 Policy Council Officers and 2 Family Service Specialists; connected 35 children in Amarillo and area with new coat.		
<i>Health:</i> Provided health screening for approximately 35 Head Start and 20 Early Head Start; completed home visit on 2 post-partum mothers and newborn babies.		
<i>Mental Wellness:</i> Conducted site visits; provided follow-up contact with teachers for 52 Head Start children whose scores indicated "behavioral concerns" on the Devereux Early Childhood Assessment (DECA).		
<i>Nutrition:</i> Completed height and weight re-screening for 165 Head Start and 33 Early Head Start children; provided follow-up assessments for 23 Head Start and 3 Early Head Start children referred for nutrition services.		
<i>USDA Meal Counts (November):</i> Breakfast 20,869; Lunch 23,838; Snack 6,908
