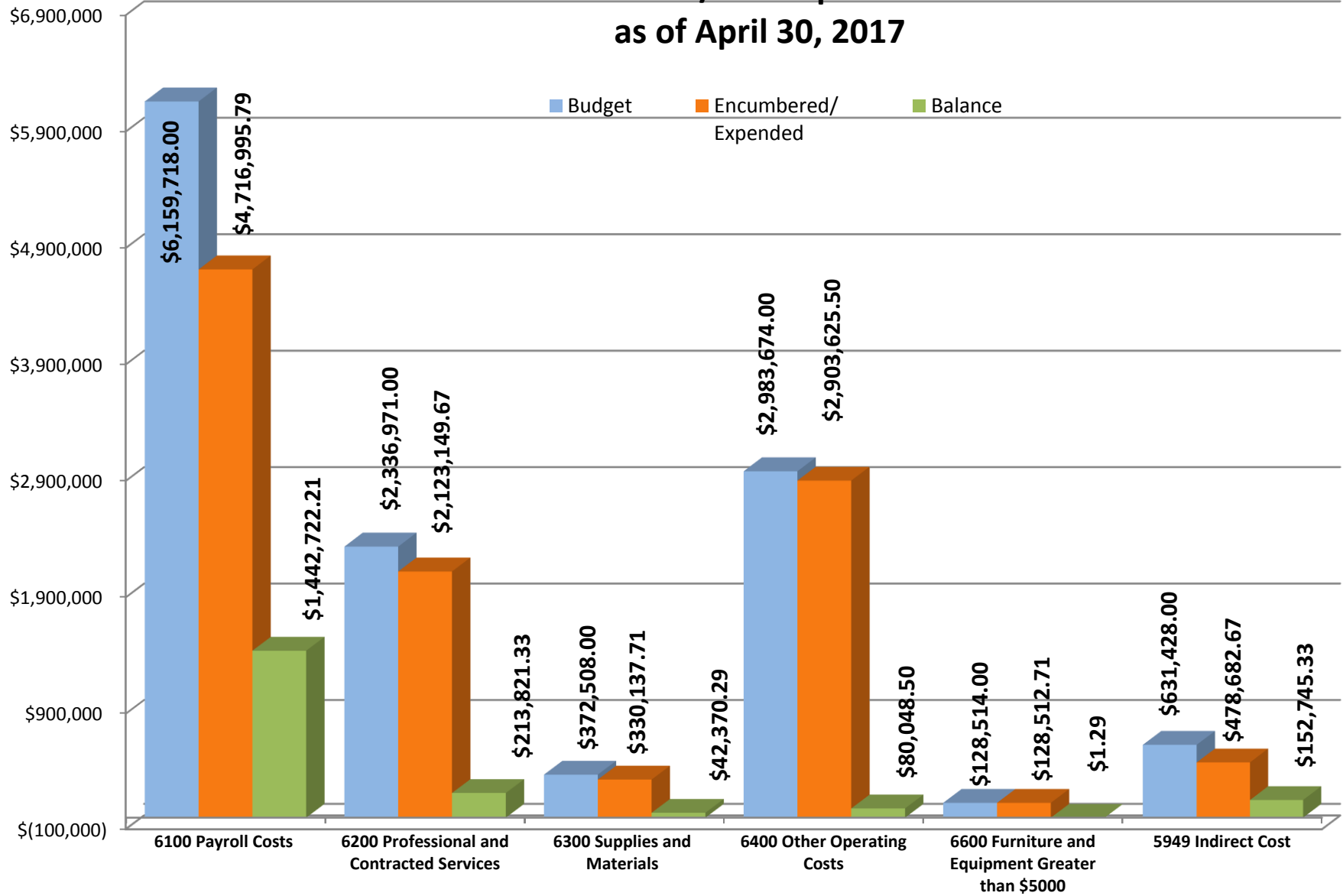


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Enrollment:</i> Head Start: 1,341 (Funded 1,341)		Early Head Start: 422 (Funded 422)

<i>Education Services:</i> Conducted 5 trainings to 22 teachers, and partnered with Panhandle Worksource to host training for 287 participants on make and take literacy; conducted Classroom Assessment Scoring System observations for 43 teachers; conducted 4 cluster trainings to discuss the transition process; conducted Teacher Learning Collaborating coaching meeting with 20 teachers.			
<i>Family Services:</i> 46 staff attended the 17 th Annual Child Abuse Prevention Conference; Courageous Conversations was presented by Health and Human Services Commission for 13 regional Family Services staff.			
<i>Health:</i> Performed screenings on 103 children with approximately 40 being completed at home visits; conducted training for 8 Early Head Start Home Educators; performed one on one trainings for 16 regional Family Service Assistants; conducted services check on all Head Start/Early Head Start sites.			
<i>Mental Wellness:</i> Started using the Mental Wellness Classroom Checklist in Early Head Start classrooms; participated in the community planning committee and conference set-up for the 17 th Annual Child Abuse Prevention Conference; completed Counselor Ethics training.			
<i>Nutrition:</i> Provided Civil Rights training (Child and Adult Care Food Program) to 15 staff members at Opportunity School; completed 46 Head Start and 49 Early Head Start height and weight screenings; monitored kitchen at Cleveland and Nelson centers for Child and Adult Care Food Program compliance.
