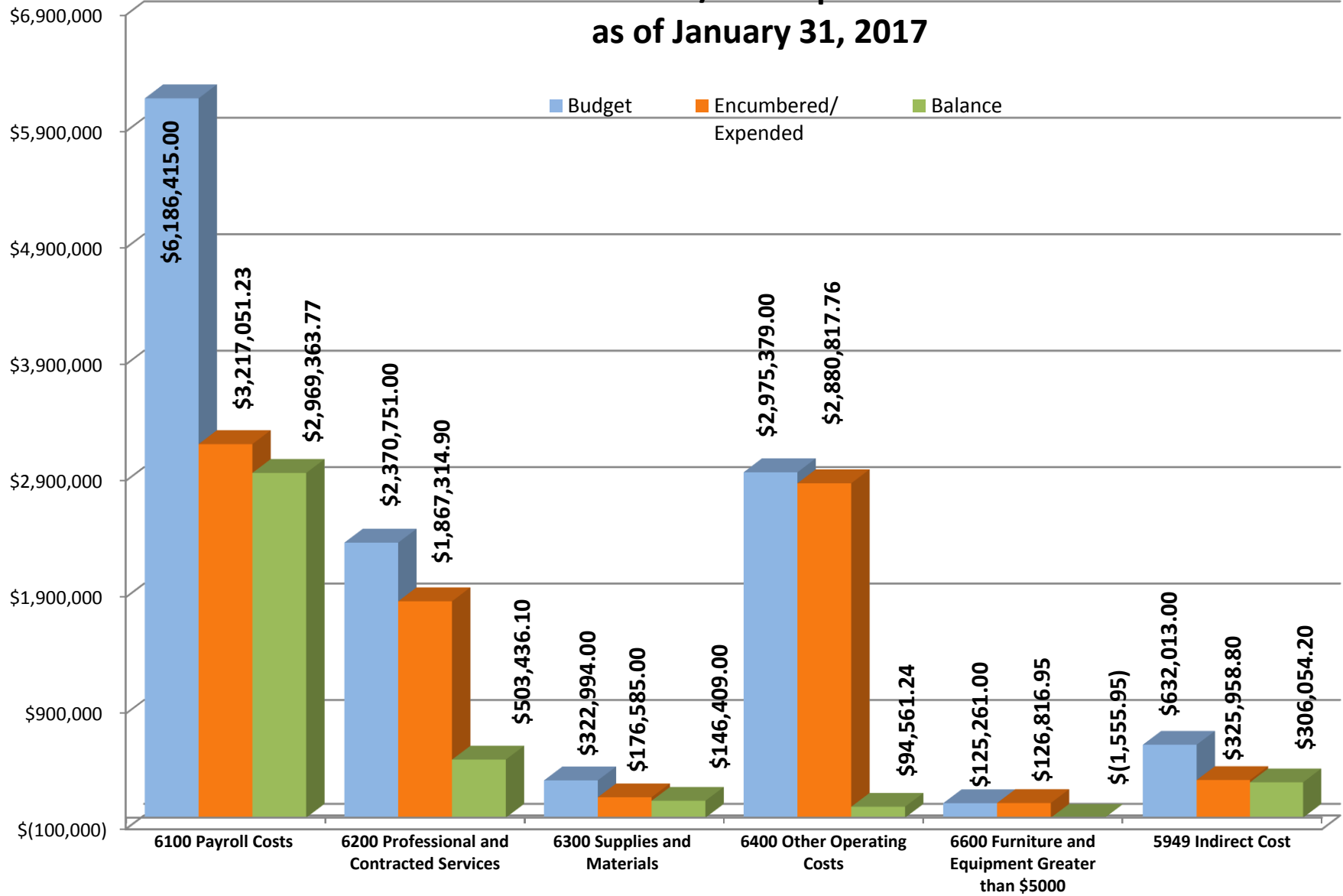


## Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Enrollment:</i> Head Start: 1,341 (Funded 1,341)		Early Head Start: 422 (Funded 422)

<i>Education Services:</i> Early Head Start staff conducted 11 trainings and 3 one on one trainings onsite total 31 directors and teachers. Head Start conducted training for 9 second year teachers, education specialists and 2 principals attended a training on the CLI assessment; 2 education specialists conducted TLC coaching sessions for 11 teachers.			
<i>Family Services:</i> Presented library services and family exercise program for 17 parents and 34 children at Cleveland Center; initiated Family Service Credential for 13 Head Start, Early Head Start, and Community family services workers; initiated transition discussions with 11 staff members and 53 families in the Early Head Start home based program.			
<i>Health:</i> Performed approximately 52 health screenings on new or Early Head Start students; continued with trainings for 3 new nurses; meeting with Early Head Start Home Base supervisor on services; mentored 8 Family Service Assistants.			
<i>Mental Wellness:</i> Attended Region 6 Wellness Institute: Supporting Wellness for Staff, Children, and Families; completed initial and renewal Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS) certification (2).			
<i>Nutrition:</i> Monitored Nelson and Cleveland centers for Child and Adult Food Program compliance; completed initial/follow-up heights and weights for 370 Head Start and 30 Early Head Start children; presented “Healthy Snacks” program at Cleveland Street for 17 parents and 34 children.			
<i>USDA Meal Counts (December):</i> Breakfast 15,686; Lunch 17,624; Snack 5,391
