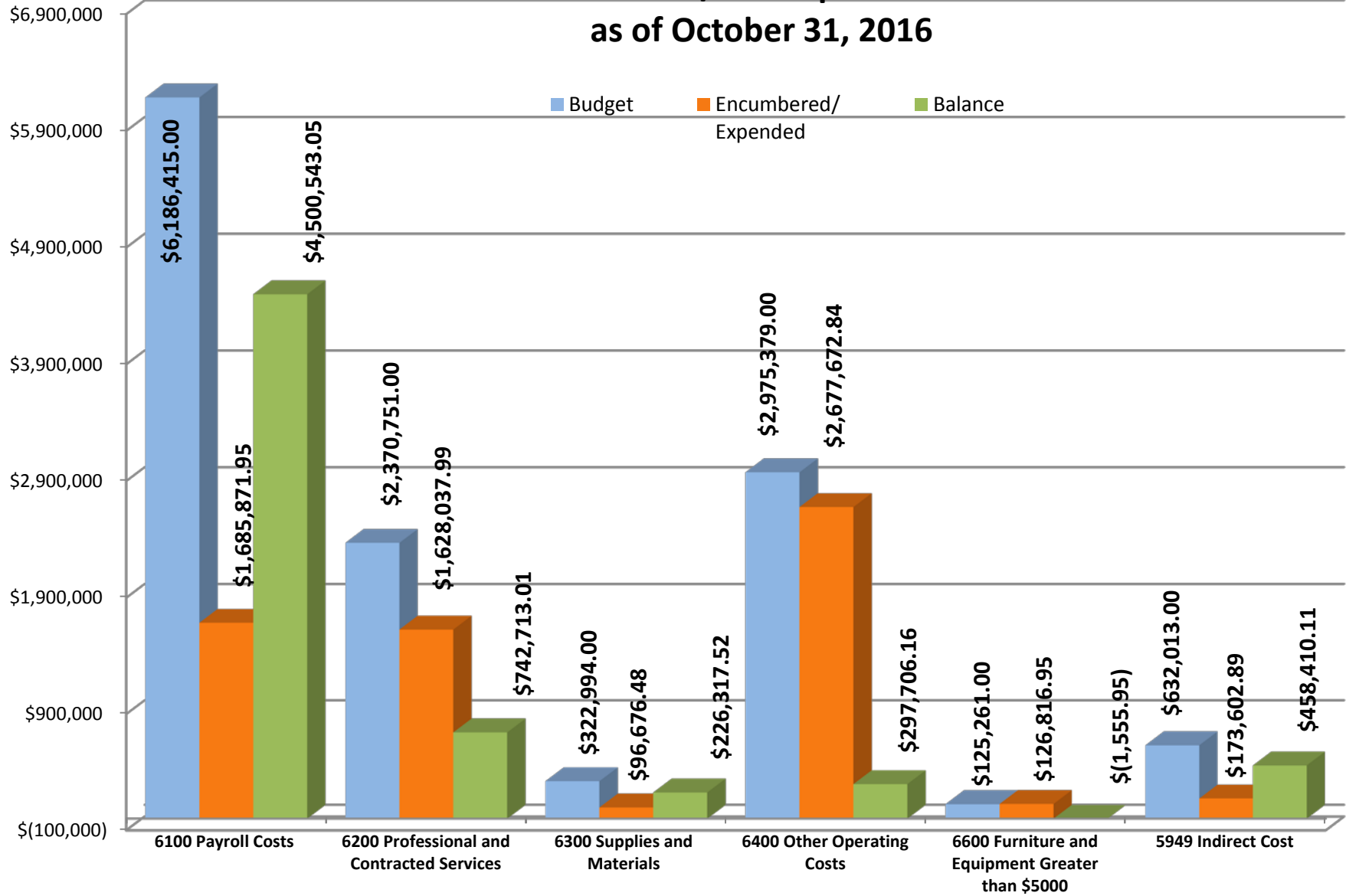


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Enrollment:</i> Head Start: 1,269 (Funded 1,341)		Early Head Start: 395 (Funded 422)

<i>Education Services:</i> Conducted Infant Toddler Environmental Rating observations at 3 sites; 17 Home Educators attended Regional Training; conducted 17 Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS) observations; conducted training for 13 new Instructional Assistants; conducted training on the Head Start Early Learning Outcomes Framework for 24 teachers.		
<i>Family Services:</i> Facilitated first Policy Council meeting with 15 representatives in attendance; collaborated with Amarillo College Student Outreach Services at 2 Early Head Start sites.		
<i>Health:</i> Assisted dentist- dental exams for 10 Regional and Amarillo Head Start/Early Head Start sites 219 students; performed regional screenings for lead and hemoglobin at 7 sites-274 screenings; assisted arranging specialty visits for 7 children needing developmental or behavior evaluations; performed required Health Status Determinations for approximately 400 students.		
<i>Mental Wellness:</i> Conducted “The Art of Stress Management” for 12 family services staff members; reviewed completion rates and results of social-emotional-behavioral screenings for enrolled students.		
<i>Nutrition:</i> Coordinated Family Fair-349 Head Start/Early Head Start participants with 30 agencies attending; conducted Child and Adult Care Food Program training for 9 administrative and 6 food service staff members.		
<i>USDA Meal Counts (September):</i> Breakfast 17,177; Lunch 20,404; Snack 6,732
