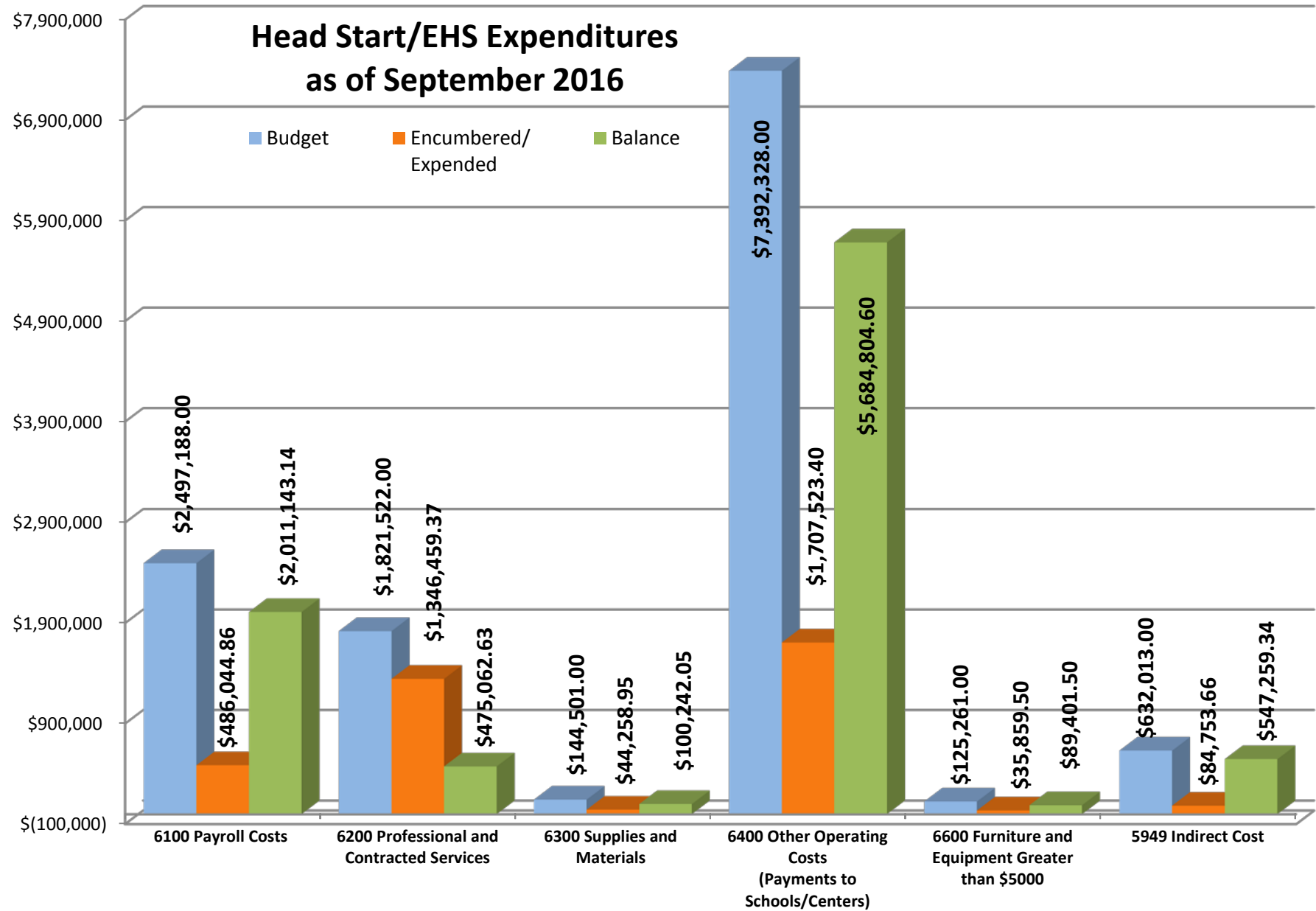


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Coordinated Services:</i> Presented Home Based parent handbook training for 14 Amarillo/Regional staff members.		
<i>Family Services:</i> completed of initial parent committee meetings at 21 Early Head Start/Head Start sites; conducted Parent Leadership Training for 70 parents and staff; conducted elections to select 12 parent representatives for Policy Council; attended a Parent, Family, and Community Engagement Institute - staff present included a Coordinator and a Family Service Specialist.		
<i>Health:</i> Performed 45-day screenings that included vision, hearing, strabismus & dental screens on 957 Head Start students and 157 Early Head Start students; performed lead and hemoglobin screening (90-day) on 84 students; dental clinic at Tulia Child Development Center for 11 students and Friona for 30 students.		
<i>Mental Wellness:</i> Presented “Mental Wellness in Early Childhood” training for 23 staff members at Nelson Street Center; provided Devereux Early Childhood Assessment teacher rating forms to all Head Start teachers for screening of students.		
<i>Nutrition:</i> Completed height and weight screening for 902 Head Start and 186 Early Head Start children; monitored Cleveland and Nelson centers for Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) compliance.		
<i>USDA Meal Counts (August):</i> Breakfast 8,401; Lunch 10,088; Snack 3,784
