



WHAT IS EARLY COMPUTATION?

Early Computation is the process to determine the GPA & Class Rank for Seniors, typically at the end of the 5th Six Weeks grading period.

Campuses should review their local policy to determine how and when the computation should be run.

NOTE: This quick reference guide is meant to highlight the steps needed to complete the Early Computation process. Use the guide under Resources (back page) for more information.

RUN EARLY COMPUTATION

GRADE REPORTING > UTILITY > GRADE AVERAGING & CLASS RANKING

There are two options when using the Early Computation fields. Use the link above for additional selections specific to your campus.

Option 1

This option is often used by two-semester nine-week campuses for Senior early computation.

- Select to process Sem 1 and Sem 2.
- Under Early Computation, select Sem2/Cyc1.

Option 2

This option is often used by two-semester six-week campuses for Senior early computation.

- Select to process Sem 1 and Sem 2.
- Under Early Computation, select Sem2/Cyc1 and Sem2/Cyc2.

VERIFY STUDENT DATA

Review and verify student's grade averages individually or by a group.

Individual

- Grade Reporting > Maint > Student Individual Maint > Grade Avg
- Grade Reporting > Reports > Grades > SGR2070 Grd Avg Info by Student (Info Only)

 Grade Reporting > Reports > Grades > SGR2075 - Cumulative Grd Avg Info by Student (Info Only)

Group

- Grade Reporting > Reports > Grades > SGR2060 Grd Avg Info by Student (Info Only)
- Grade Reporting > Reports > Grades > SGR2075 Cumulative Grd Avg Info by Student (Info Only)

RUN CUMULATIVE GPA/CLASS RANK

GRADE REPORTING > UTILITIES > CUMULATIVE GRADE AVERAGING & CLASS RANKING

This utility **MUST BE RUN** anytime the Grade Averaging & Class Ranking Utility is run for the cumulative GPA to update. At early computation time (typically after 5th six weeks has ended) schools will run for seniors to determine the valedictorian and salutatorian.

Use the link above for additional selections specific to your campus. Additionally, the reports mentioned to review student data can also be used for review once the cumulative utility is run.

The Grade Averaging & Class Ranking and Cumulative Grade Average and Class Ranking utilities needs to be run again at the end of the school year to update OTHER grade levels. See district policy to determine if 12th grade should be run again.

PRINT AAR'S

AAR/Transcripts can be printed two ways:

- Multiple students
 Grade Reporting > Reports > Grade Reporting Reports > Grades > SGR2047 AAR Multi-Year
- Individual student
 Grade Reporting > Maintenance > Student > Individual Maint > Cumulative Courses
