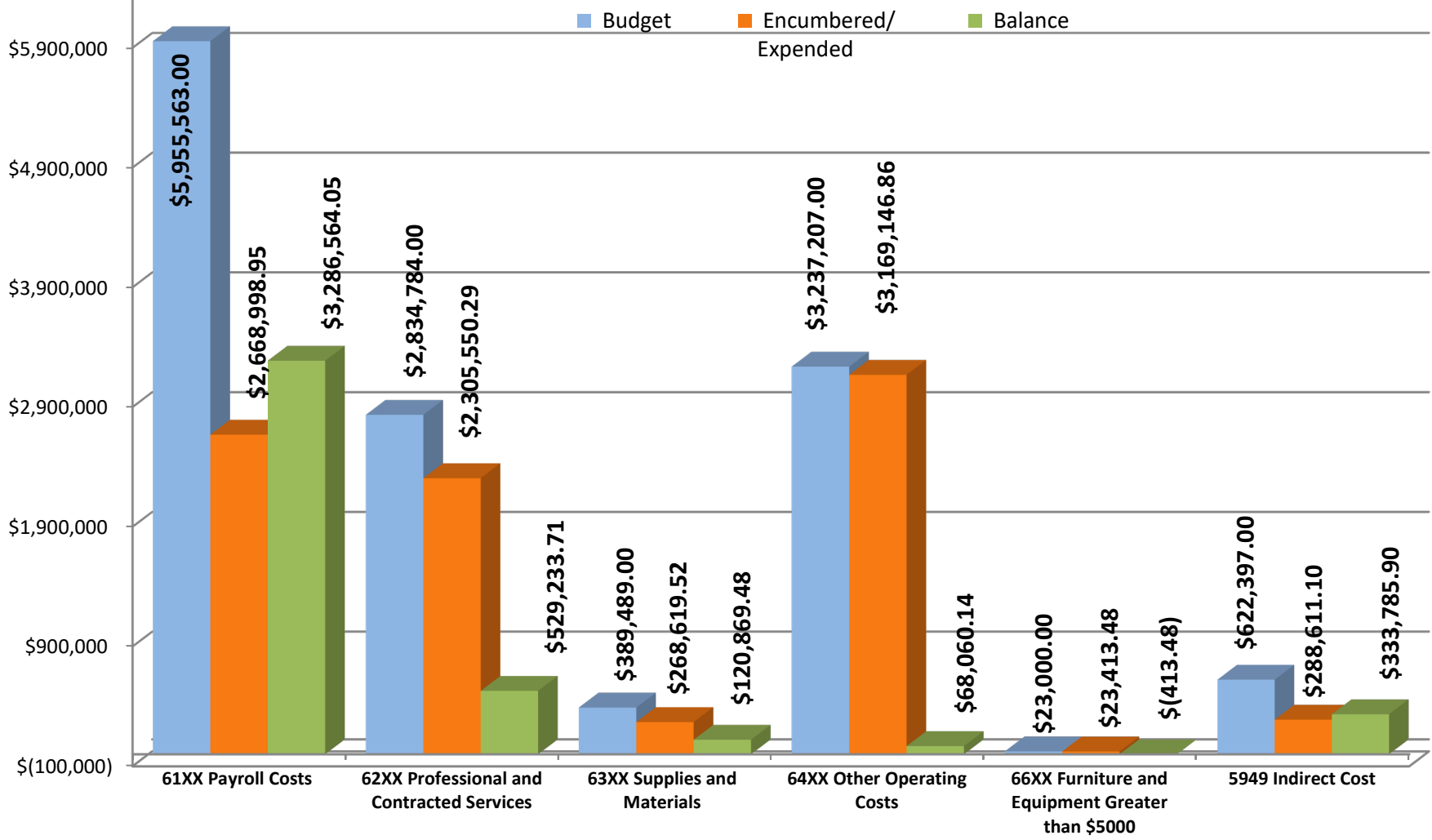


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Health: Attended the networking for kids; attended 8 specialty medical appointments for children; training on Sudden Infant Death Syndrome for Early Head Start new employees; created two partnerships - Regence Health Network and Harvester Wellness Clinic; obtained medical supplies and medication for 12 families in need.</i>		
<i>Family Services: Presented Conscious Discipline mini-session Helping Children Handle Big Emotions to 238 parents in Amarillo and regional sites; provided Conscious Discipline training to 36 Family Service Assistants to prepare for the Spring Semester of the Parent Curriculum; assisted 30 regional children's families with Christmas assistance; connected 4 Cleveland families with enrollment assistance at Amarillo College.</i>		
<i>Mental Wellness: Prioritized site visits and consultation based on reduced school schedules in the month of December; approximately 80% of sites were visited.</i>		
<i>Nutrition: Completed heights and weights for 15 new Early Head Start children and 227 Head Start children at high risk; attended and passed ServSafe training taken by Nutrition Specialists.</i>		
<i>USDA Meal Counts (November): Breakfast 15,912; Lunch 18,564; Snack 7,159</i>
