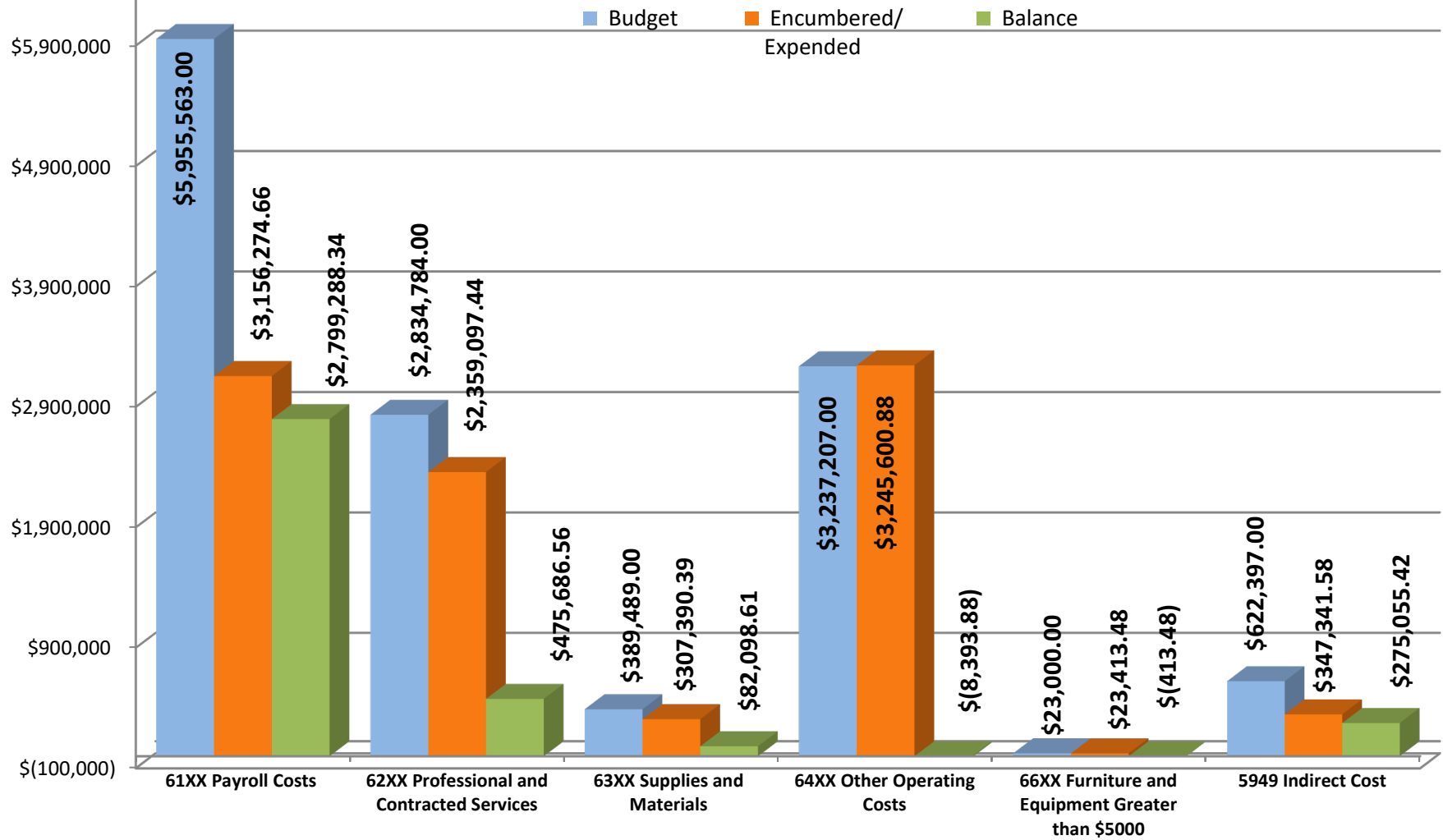


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Early Head Start Education:</i> Provided training in Conscious Discipline: Evaluating the Journey-22 staff; provided transition and active supervision training for 5 staff; provided Conscious Discipline: Encouragement training for 5 staff; completed Focused Observation/Teaching Strategies Gold documentation training for all of Memphis ISD.		
<i>Head Start Education:</i> Discussed “Needs Assessment for Teaching Practices” questionnaire with all regional teachers; continued work on Head Start coaching plan; attended the introduction meeting for “My Teachstone” for Director of Direct Services and Head Start Education Specialists.		
<i>Family Services:</i> Attended Parent Family Community Engagement Framework training provided by Region 6 Office of Regional Operations for 1 Family Service Specialist and Assistant Director; provided training to 61 parents over the Conscious Discipline skill of encouragement; hosted a Policy Council meeting with 7 parents and 4 community representatives present; provided the first 2 days of Family Service Credential training for 7 Head Start staff, 8 Early Head Start staff, and 8 family services workers with agencies in Amarillo, Lubbock, and Snyder.		
<i>Health:</i> Attended Region VI wellness training; performed health screenings on 142 Head Start and Early Head Start children throughout the region; scheduled 30 dental appointments for Early Head Start/Head Start children; assessed 6 pregnant and postpartum women; attended 9 developmentally pediatrician appointments with Head Start Children.		
<i>Mental Wellness:</i> Presented at policy council on mental health and father engagement; presented at Pampa Lamar on Conscious Discipline (Basic Overview and Review); began formal review of social, emotional, behavioral screening and possible options for next school year.		
<i>Nutrition:</i> Completed 174 height and weight re-checks 121 Head Start and 53 Early Head Start; presented nutrition programs at 4 parent meetings and 1 Group Socialization Activity for 18 parents and 13 children.
