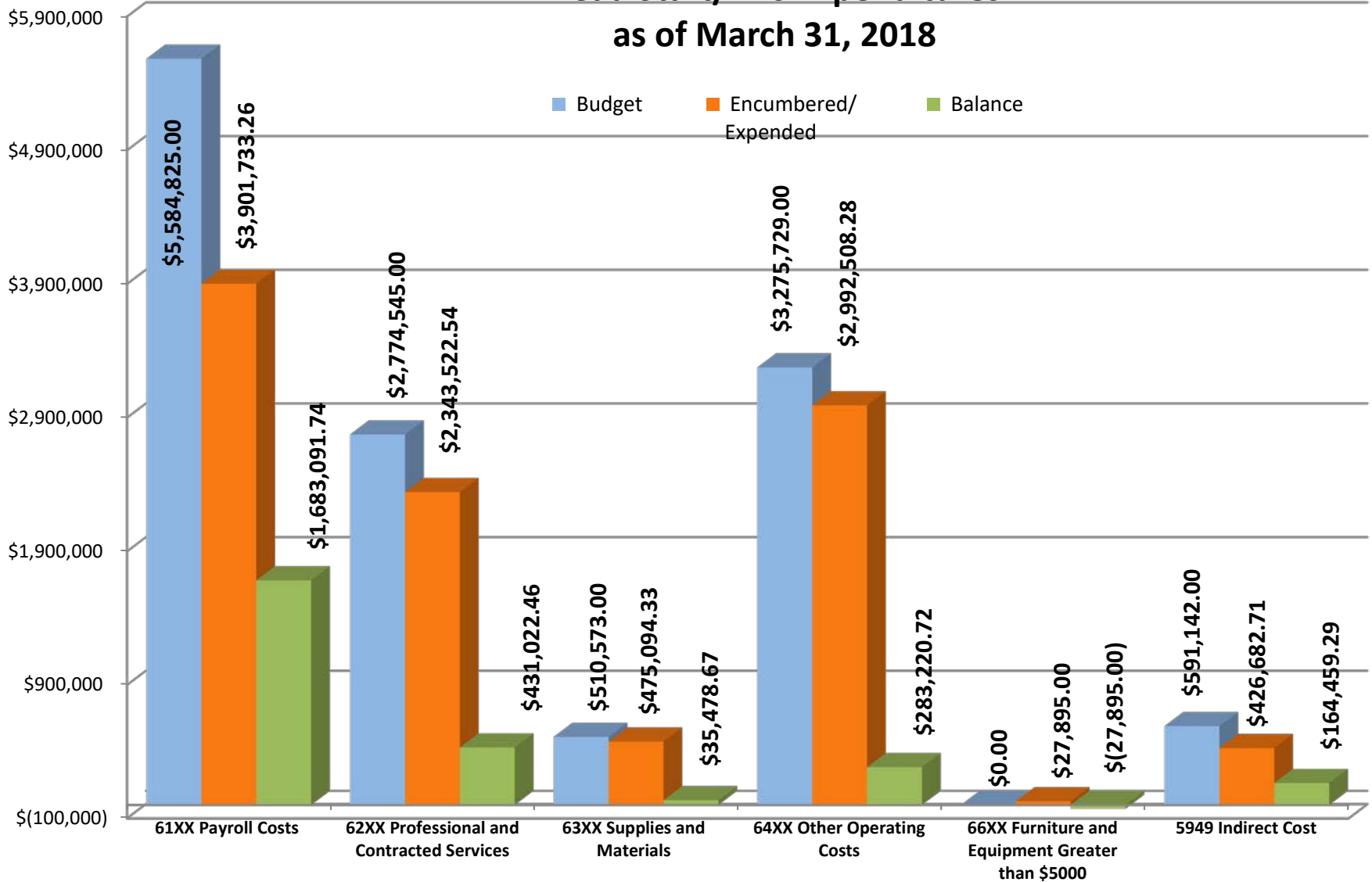


## Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Early Head Start Education:</i> Completed curriculum and assessment trainings for 44 Early Head Start teachers/directors; completed Conscious Discipline training for 23 Early Head Start teachers; completed transition training for 17 Early Head Start teachers/directors; enrolled 11 new families into three new Early Head Start classrooms at the Cleveland Center.		
<i>Head Start Education:</i> Conducted transition and home visit training for 39 teachers during cluster meetings; received training from Children’s Learning Institute personnel on program data - 4 education specialists, assistant director and administrative assistant.		
<i>Family Services:</i> Provided Conscious Discipline Parenting Curriculum training for 47 family service staff and one area school counselor; continued Family Service Credential training to 11 Head Start/Early Head Start, and Community Family Service staff; presented pre-kindergarten enrollment for AISD to 16 parents; facilitated Nutrition and Health Family Engagement; conducted Egg Hunts for all Cleveland and Nelson students and families utilizing parents as volunteers to help prepare the hunts for each classroom.		
<i>Health:</i> Conducted screenings for 100 Head Start/Early Head Start students, reviewed health policies.		
<i>Mental Wellness:</i> Provided “Introduction to Conscious Discipline Parenting Curriculum” for 15 parents in Perryton and 12 parents in Memphis.		
<i>Nutrition:</i> Completed final heights and weights for 1040 Head Start and 72 Early Head Start children; conducted parent meeting at Cleveland center for 16 parents and 16 children; prepared for expansion of Cleveland Early Head Start classrooms to comply with Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) regulations.
