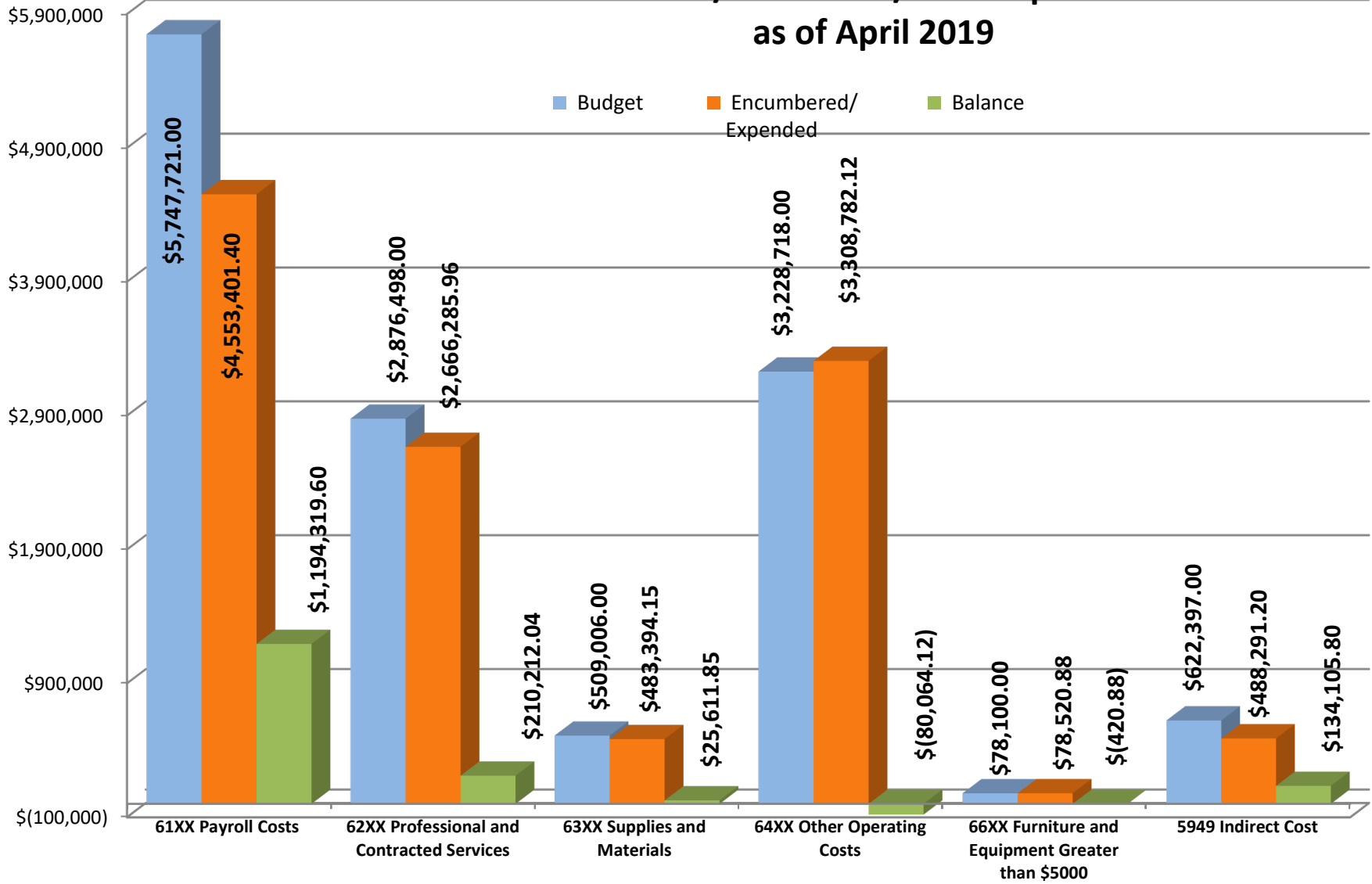


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Early Head Start Education:</i> Completed Class Assessment Scoring System observations for 44 Early Head Start teachers; completed active supervision training for 24 Early Head Start staff; completed Conscious Discipline Positive Intent training for 8 teachers; completed Nurturing Interactions training for 6 Early Head Start staff.		
<i>Head Start Education:</i> Completed 24 Class Assessment Scoring System observations; attended a training on Resilience.		
<i>Family Services:</i> Attended National Head Start Association Conference-2 Family Service Specialist; completed home visit observations for 10 home educators; provided Conscious Discipline training over the Power of Love and the Skill of Positive Intent to parents at 20 Head Start sites, facilitated a Transition and Summer Resource Fair for Cleveland and Nelson families with 92 parents attending; provided CPR/First Aid training to 3 parents from the Cleveland.		
<i>Health:</i> Attended National Head Start Association conference; conducted health screenings on 40 Head Start children and 12 Early Head Start children; assisted with health intake for over 50 families during application day; accompanied 7 Head Start families to medical appointments.		
<i>Mental Wellness:</i> Conducted "Conscious Discipline" training for 14 classroom staff in Pampa; assisted with Classroom Assessment Scoring System observations for 18 teachers throughout the region; attended the 2019 National Head Start Association Conference.		
<i>Nutrition:</i> Presented Healthy Snacks/Eating Healthy on a budget to 34 parents and 41 children at Cleveland/Nelson parent meeting; reported about Farm Fresh Challenge conducted in March to 16 Health Advisory Committee members; conducted required Child and Adult Care Food Program monitoring at Cleveland and Nelson centers.
