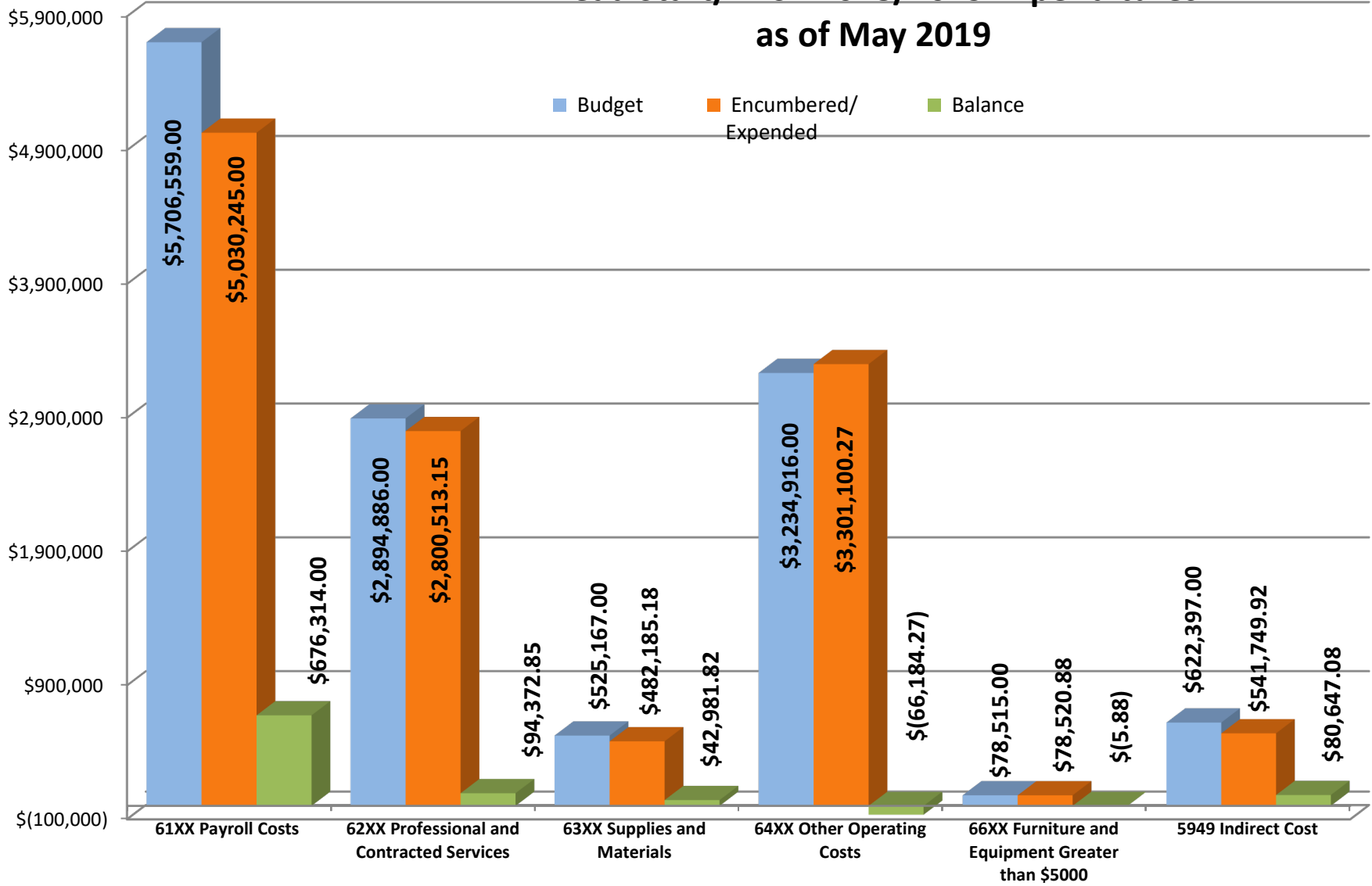


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Early Head Start Education:</i> Completed training for 20 Early Head Start teachers working with children and families with disabilities; completed Conscious Discipline training in Consequences for 24 Early Head Start staff members; completed Infant Toddler Environment Rating Scale (ITERS-R) observations for 64 Early Head Start teachers.		
<i>Head Start Education:</i> Completed Children’s Learning Institute assessments for all Head Start students; completed ChildPlus entries for all education components; 4 Head Start education specialists met with Patricia Rodriguez Training/Technical Assistant for the Head Start program to discuss the coaching plan and coaching options.		
<i>Family Services:</i> Offered Conscious Discipline parenting education ‘Ways Children Can be Helpful’ at 22 Head Start sites and to Home Base families; attended National Head Start Association Conference by two Family Services Specialists and the Assistant Director; facilitated Site Navigator training for 44 family service staff to be able to assist with Texas Health and Human Service applications.		
<i>Health:</i> Assisted a Head Start partner site with health intake; screened 30 Head Start and Early Head Start students; assessed six pregnant women; presented policy changes to policy council; attended 6 medical appointments with Head Start students.		
<i>Mental Wellness:</i> Attended National Head Start Association Conference; served approximately 30 students with observation and/or follow-up; began planning process for staff trainings for the 2019-20 grant year.		
<i>Nutrition:</i> Presented Nutrition Group Socialization Activity to 14 Head Start families and 18 Head Start students; completed and filed referrals for regional sites; coordinated with Canyon ISD Food Service Director staffing for 2019-20 Cleveland and Nelson center.		
<i>USDA Meal Counts (April):</i> Breakfast 24,053; Lunch 27,424; Snack 8,517
