Early Head Start Education: Completed summer checkpoints in Teaching Strategies Gold assessment for all Early Head Start students; facilitated Child Care Licensing overview training for 23 Early Head Start Directors and staff; created schedule for Infant/Toddler Environmental Rating Scale-3 (ITERS-3) Fall observations.

Head Start Education: Provided introductory training for 24 new Head Start teachers and 8 second year teachers; provided assessment, screening, ChildPlus, learning centers and letter wall training for 14 new Head Start teachers and 7 second year teachers; 3 Head Start specialists attended curriculum training.

Family Services: Met with Community Partner Liaison to plan Family Services staff training for Health and Human Services benefits; provided preservice training to 43 family service staff over procedure updates and best practices in family services; planned Conscious Discipline kickoff events at Head Start sites.

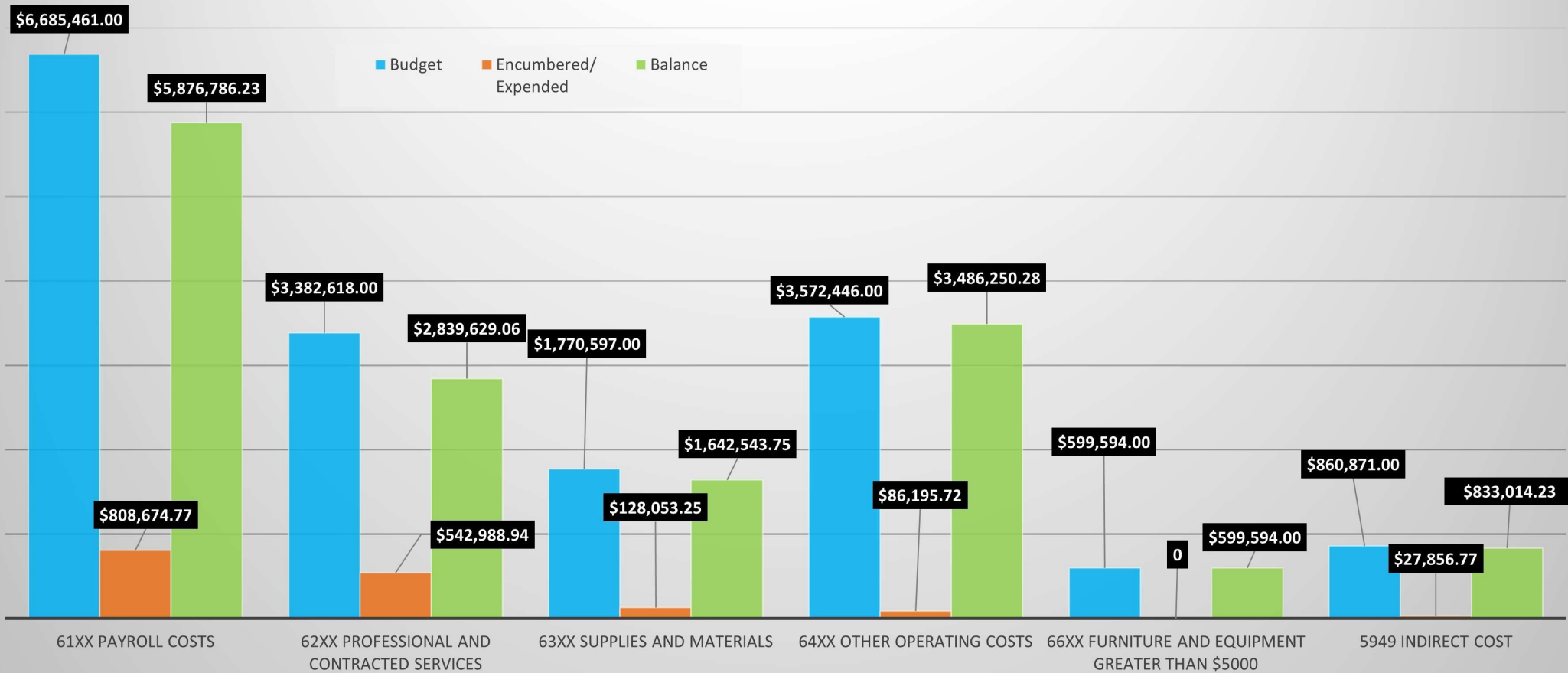
Health: Performed health screenings on 182 Early Head Start children; attended 13 home visits; completed health admission for Cleveland and Nelson Meet and Greet; conducted training for Family Service Assistants over health and nutrition updates.

Mental Wellness: Completed staff wellness newsletter tips for father engagement and mental health; reviewed site assignments and revised mental wellness visit checklist; provided initial support visits to Cleveland, Nelson, Dalhart, Dumas, Canyon Lakeview, and Stratford.

Nutrition: Completed height and weight screening for 177 EHS and 14 HS children; provided annual Child and Adult Care Food Program training for staff at Cleveland and Nelson Centers; conducted pre-service training for Family Services Assistants on nutrition topics.
