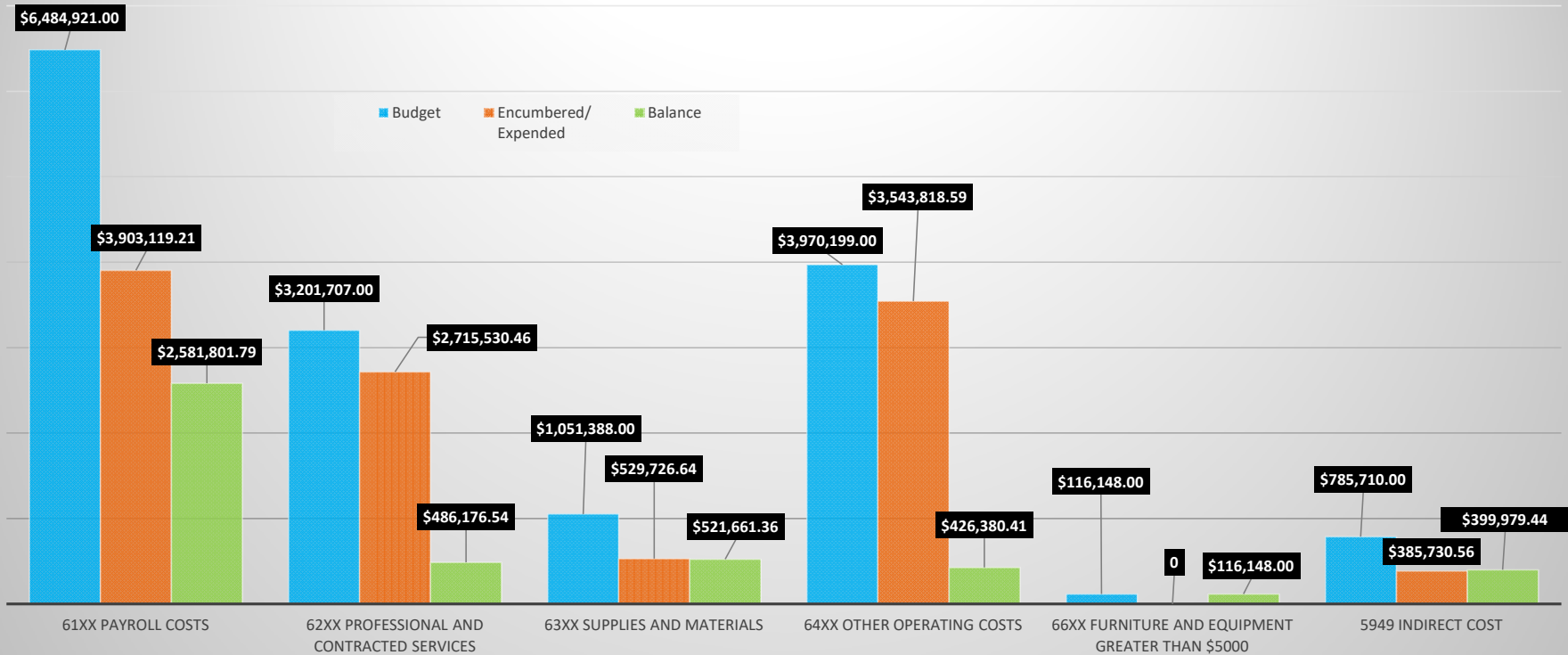


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<p>Head Start Education: created Children’s Learning Institute Assessment training for all Head Start teachers; completed 18 Classroom Assessment Scoring System observations; attended a mental wellness webinar entitled “Recognizing and Addressing Trauma in Infants, Young Children and Their Families” and “The Impact of Covid-19 on Your Health & Strategies for Self-Care”.</p>		
<p>Family Services: Attended Parents as Teachers Regional Training with 11 Home-Based staff; provided days 1 and 2 of Family Service Credential training to 12 family service staff; met with 33 family service staff to discuss empathy and practice active listening skills.</p>		
<p>Health: Performed health screenings on 39 Head Start children and 100 Early Head Start children; attended the West Texas Health Managers meeting; conducted a cardiopulmonary resuscitation booster and certification skills class for 12 Early Head Start teachers</p>		
<p>Mental Wellness: Attended “The Impact of COVID-19 on Mental Health” and “Recognizing and Addressing Trauma in Infants, Young Children and Their Families” webinars (2 specialists); provided “Father Engagement Article and Video – Second Quarter Training” to all staff via email.</p>		
<p>Nutrition: Revised nutrition policies for Policy Council approval in March; completed heights and weights for 39 Head Start and 100 Early Head Start children; conducted Child and Adult Care Food Program training for 3 new employees.</p>
