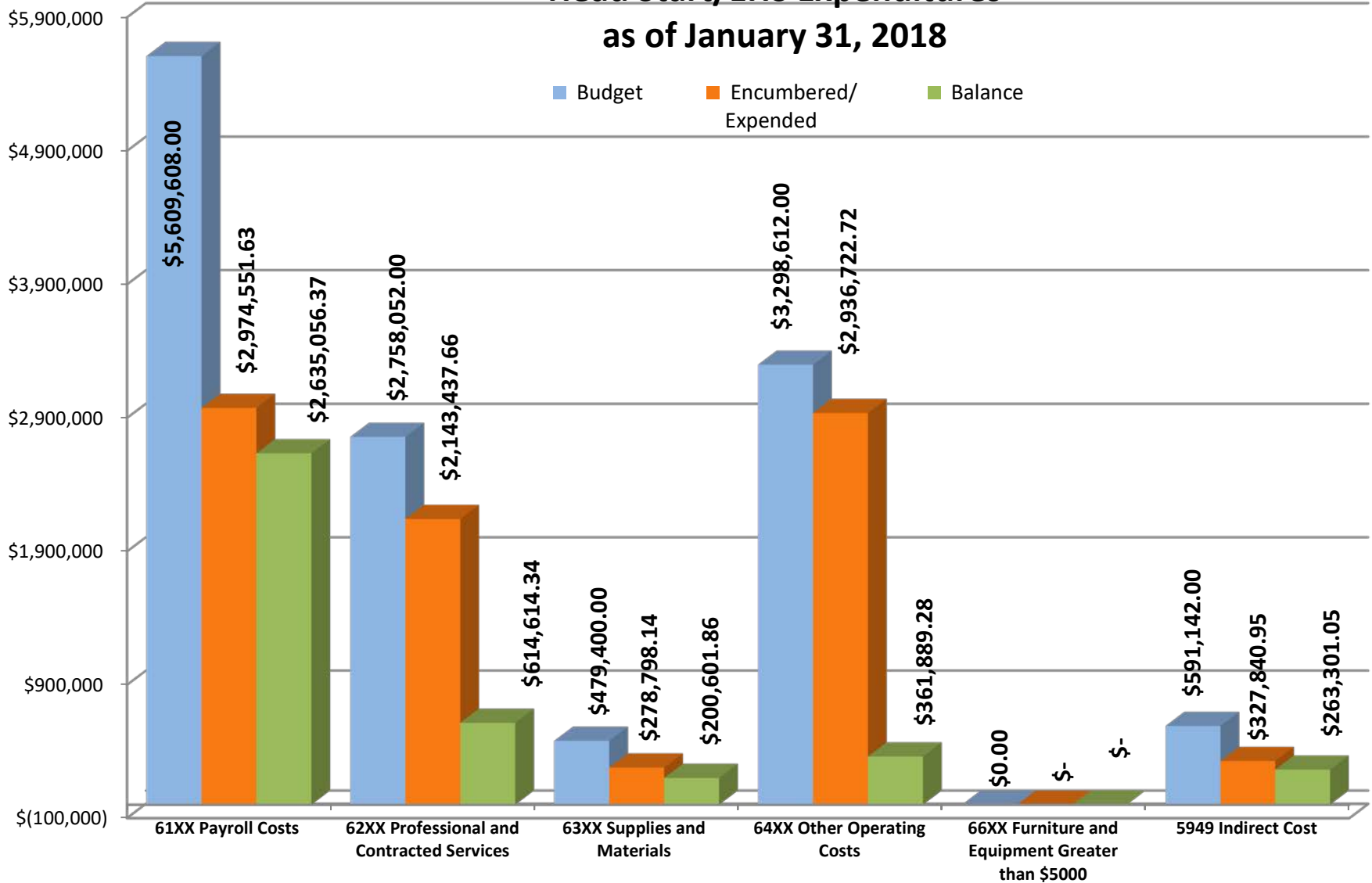


## Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Early Head Start Education:</i> Attended Individualized Instruction training-43 teachers & 3 directors; completed Federal Monitoring mock interviews via video conference-16 teachers & 5 directors; conducted Infant/Toddler Environmental Rating Scale evaluations-31 classrooms.		
<i>Head Start Education:</i> Completed training prepare/related to monitoring 59 teachers and 16 instructional aides; attend Teachers Learning and Collaborating session – 10 teachers; facilitated Professional Learning Communities session – 15 teachers; participated in coaching - 41 Teachers; conducted Brigance screenings to 7 new students.		
<i>Family Services:</i> Provided Amarillo and regional family service staff with training to prepare for federal monitoring review; facilitated a Fathers Add Value training for 35 fathers/father figures; worked with family service staff to revisit and update every enrolled families’ strength, needs, and goals.		
<i>Health:</i> Completed screenings on 45 Early Head Start/40 Head Start students; attended Mindfulness training nursing staff(5); completed federal monitoring Focus Area 2; visited potential partnering dental office.		
<i>Mental Wellness:</i> Conducted training in the “Art of Stress Management” for 7 Early Head Start staff members; provided training on the “Devereux Early Childhood Assessment” for 47 staff members in Head Start/Early Head Start.		
<i>Nutrition:</i> Completed 223 height and weight re-checks; conducted interactive nutrition training for 8 parents and 15 children at Amarillo Group Socialization Activity; attended Master Wellness Volunteer training through Agri-Life Extension.
