

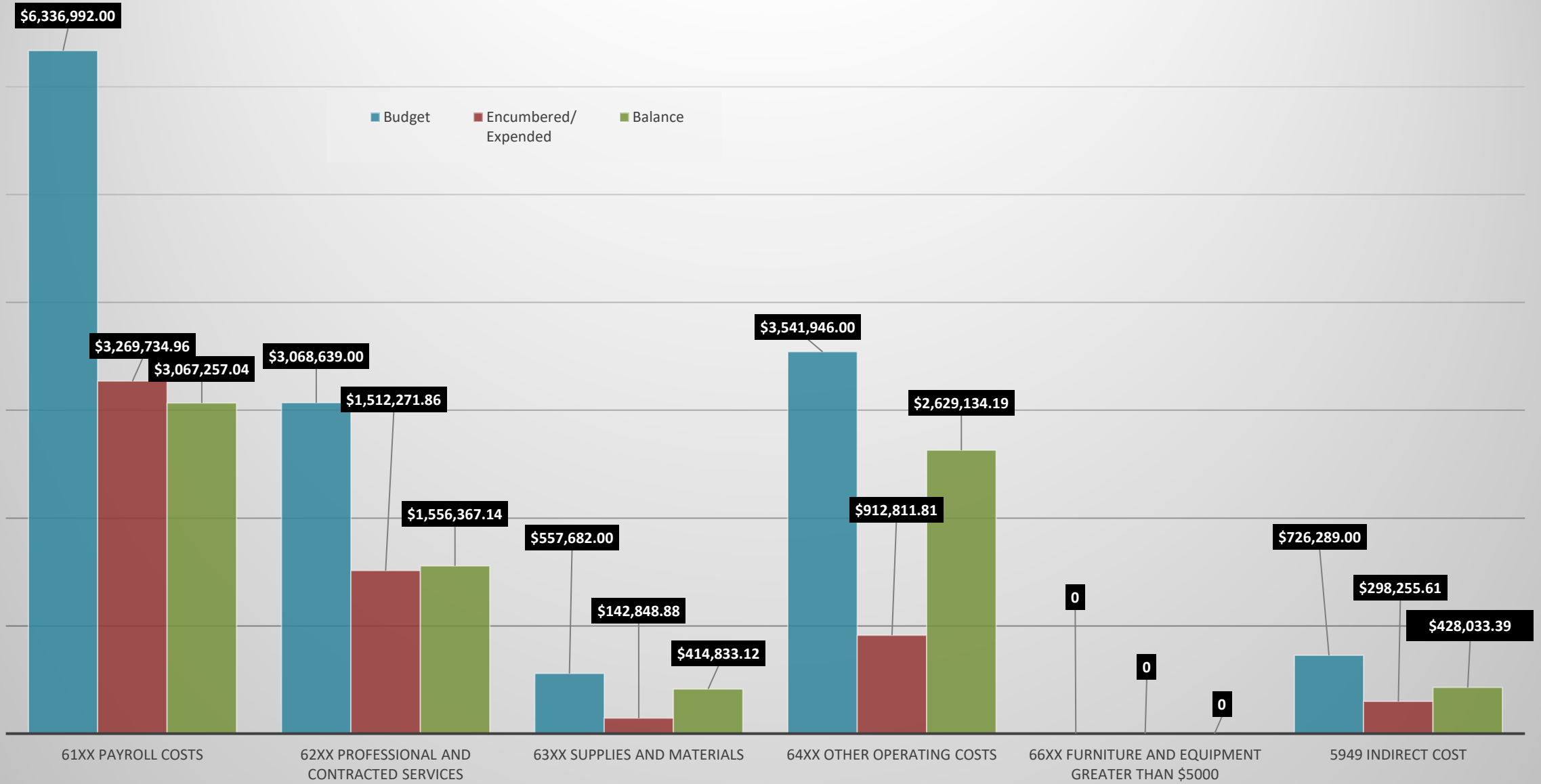
Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<p>Early Head Start Education: Provided Conscious Discipline Baby Doll Circle Time training for 6 teachers and 1 director; discussed Conscious Discipline training plan with 1 director; planned and scheduled room for spring Saturday training for all of Early Head Start staff.</p>
<p>Head Start Education: Teachers started the middle of the year (Wave 2) assessment for all Head Start students; Head Start specialist and Education Coordinator completed requirements for CIRCLE Pre-K Foundations certification; one Head Start specialist completed the Classroom Assessment Scoring System recertification.</p>
<p>Family Services: Assisted Policy Council officers in facilitating Policy Council for 5 parent representatives and 3 community representatives; provided training to 38 family services staff members regarding collecting and documenting program information; began Family Service Credential training for 18 Head Start/Early Head Start staff and 4 community agency staff.</p>
<p>Health: Attended two specialist appointments with Head Start families; preformed health screenings for 25 Head Start children and 19 Early Head Start children.</p>
<p>Mental Wellness: Researched and prepared training to be presented to instructional assistants in February; prepared self-care gift bags to be presented to staff members attending Spring training (teachers, instructional assistants, and family services assistants).</p>
<p>Nutrition: Monitored Cleveland and Nelson kitchens for Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) compliance; completed nutrition article for Employee Wellness newsletter; completed follow-up growth assessments for 209 Head Start and 17 Early Head Start children.</p>
