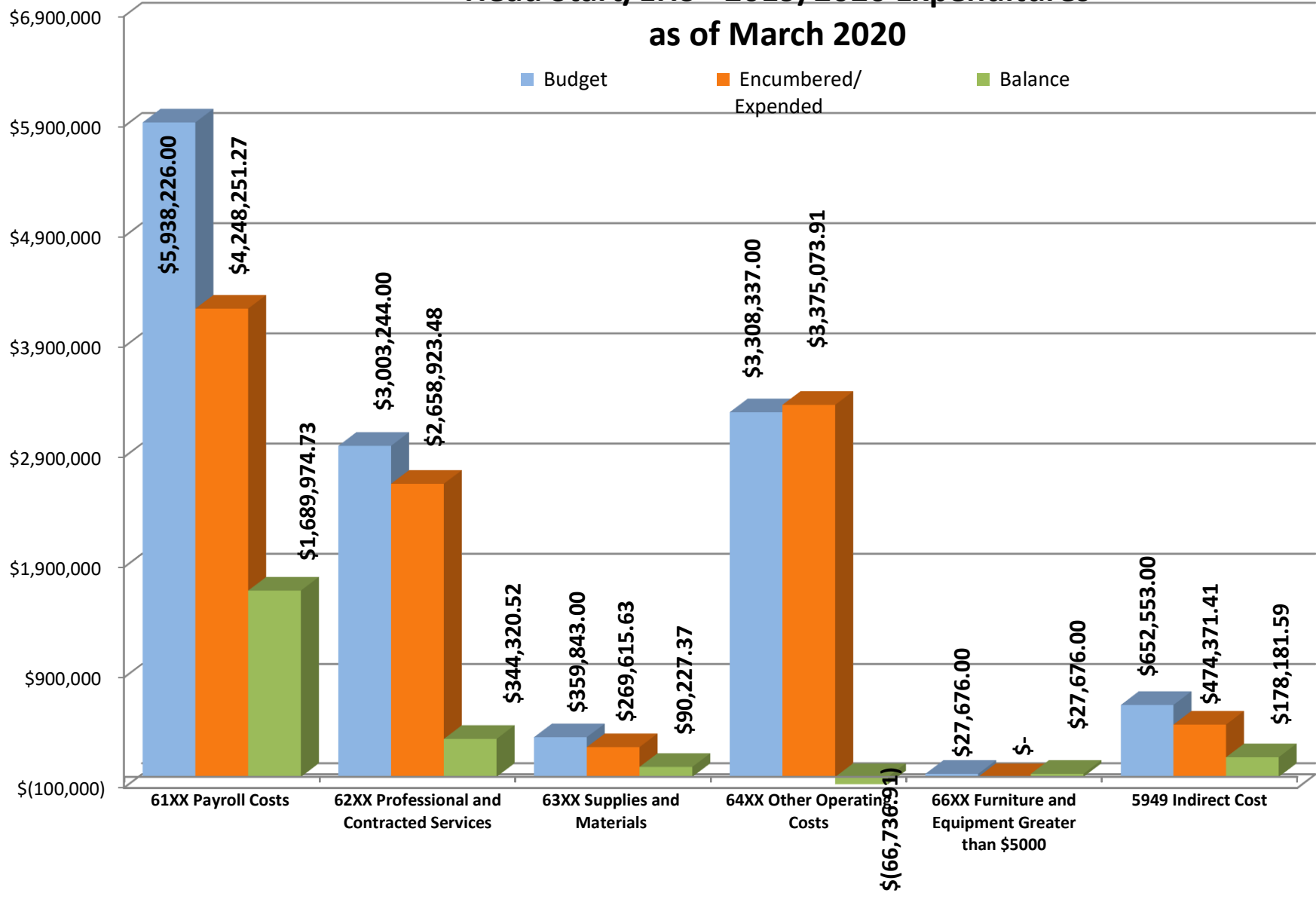


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

March 2020

Early Head Start Education: Completed 4 social emotional and 4 developmental screeners through remote home visits; 12 center-based sites implemented digital format Infant/Toddler Creative Curriculum lessons to share with families; provided access and support for 12 Early Head Start sites implementing remote services for their families through various software/modals; completed new teacher training for 12 Early Head Start Staff members (due to COVID-19 accommodations)		
Head Start Education: Conducted cluster trainings for 41 classroom assistants; conducted cluster trainings for 45 classroom teachers; conducted Professional Learning Communities for each regional site via Google Meets (due to COVID-19)		
Family Services: Implemented virtual home visits via Zoom for Home Base families; assisted Policy Council Chair in facilitating Policy Council via Zoom for 8 Parent Representatives and 2 Community Representatives. Provided training regarding remote services to family service staff via Zoom.		
Health: Completed training for hand washing and cough etiquette to Cleveland/Nelson classroom staff; attended 9 medical appointments with Head Start families; assisted nutrition with heights and weights for EHS and HS students.		
Mental Wellness: Completed site visits for approximately 50% of sites prior to spring break; provided email support to all teachers and phone support to teachers and families with additional needs during time of working remotely.		
Nutrition: Completed final height and weight screening for 896 HS and 75 EHS children; attended meeting with Environmental Health Department regarding meals during COVID-19; attended 2 USDA webinars for COVID-19 updates.
