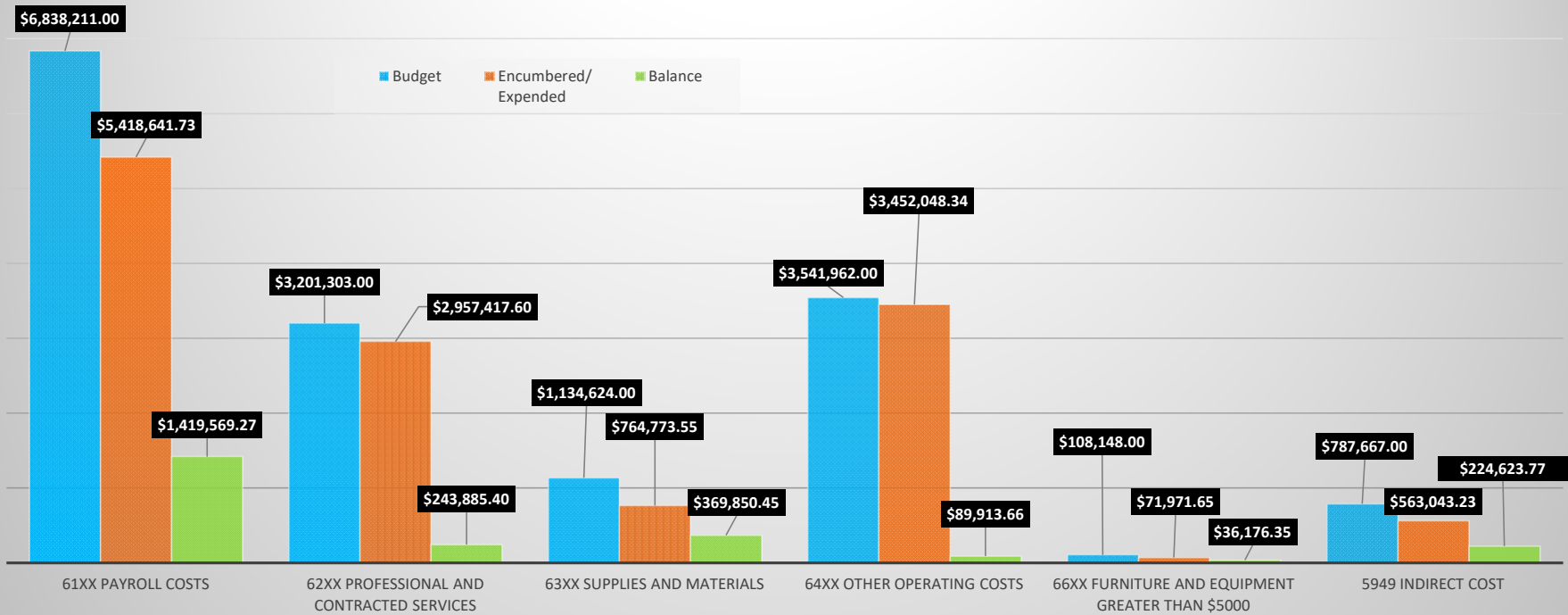


## Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<i>Enrollment:</i>	Head Start: 1,079 (Funded 1,341)	Early Head Start: 360 (Funded 422)

<p><b>Early Head Start Education:</b> We had 33 Infant Toddler Environmental Rating Scales (ITERS-3) observations scored; feedback shared with 60 teachers and 10 directors. Spring completed for all children in Teaching Strategies Gold Assessments; screeners completed, and results shared at end of year home visits for all center-based children.</p>		
<p><b>Head Start Education:</b> Completed the Children’s Learning Institute assessment for all Head Start students; attended SAVVAS training provided by the company</p>		
<p><b>Family Services:</b> Assisted Policy Council Chair in facilitating Policy Council for 8 parent representatives and 1 community representative; attended the Community Status Report luncheon hosted by the United Way of Amarillo/Canyon; participated in Train the Trainer updates for Family Service Credential; planned annual training over policy and procedure updates for Early Head Start family services staff; finalized goals with Head Start families.</p>		
<p><b>Health:</b> Performed health screenings on 27 Head Start children and 34 Early Head Start children; attended 4 medical appointments with Head Start families; assisted in providing dental education for a Head Start site; conducted training for family service assistant over health paperwork.</p>		
<p><b>Mental Wellness:</b> Presented “Using Conscious Discipline with Challenging Behavior” training to 18 staff members in Dimmitt; researched and prepared video series “Introduction to Trauma Part 1 and Part 2” for fall preservice.</p>		
<p><b>Nutrition:</b> Monitored Nelson center for Child and Adult Care Food Program compliance; conducted training on completion of Infant Production Record for 14 Early Head Start classroom staff; coordinated with Chartwells to provide summer meal service to children at Cleveland center.</p>
