Early Head Start Education: Completed developmental checkpoints in Teaching Strategies Gold ongoing assessment for all Early Head Start children; 19 Early Head Start staff in Pampa completed training on curriculum, transitions, and hands-on learning; began planning spring Saturday training for all of Early Head Start.

Head Start Education: Education Specialists provided training on centers, Children's Learning Institute data, challenging behaviors, and transitions for 58 Head Start teachers; conducted 10 Classroom Assessment Scoring system observations for new Head Start teachers;

Family Services: Provided training to 3 Policy Council officers regarding meeting protocol and procedures; assisted Policy Council Chair in facilitating Policy Council meeting for 5 Parent Representatives and 3 Community Representatives; coordinated a Community Connection for 24 families who received support with utility bills, housing, and/or assistance applying for health insurance.

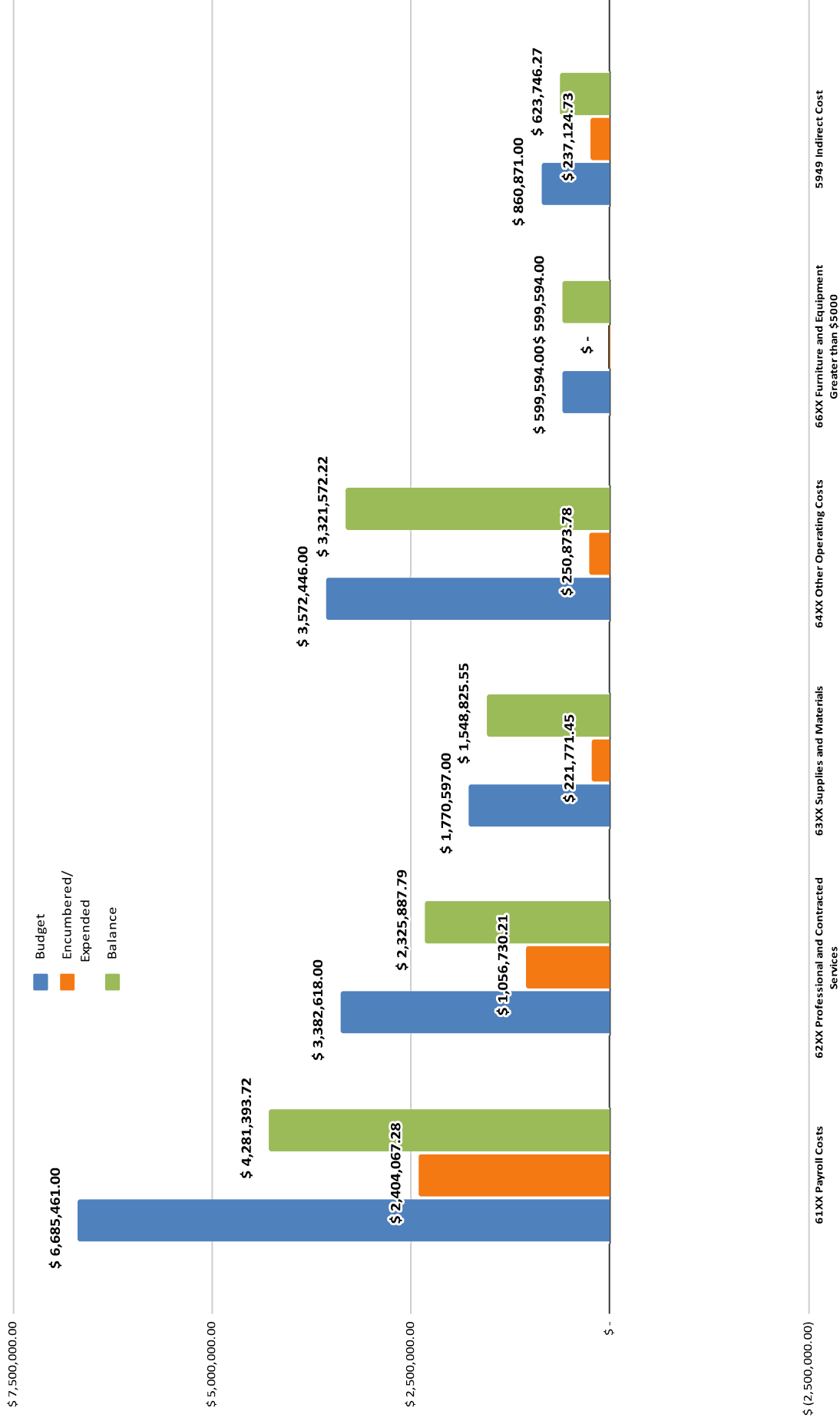
Health: Collaborated with Amarillo Independent School District to implement home based pregnancy program for pregnant students; participated in precepting 5 Amarillo College nursing students; attended 6 medical appointments with Head Start children and families

Mental Wellness: Provided live training to 47 teachers on the topics of "The Trauma Lens & Challenging Behavior" and "What Keeps You Ticking - Secondary Trauma & Self-Care"; presented online training to 29 family services staff on the topic of "Shifting the Trauma Lens/Secondary Trauma & Self-Care".

Nutrition: Presented nutrition program for 8 adults and 6 children at 2 Group Socialization Activities; provided preceptor guidance for 2 Dietetic Interns from Texas Tech University; developed December nutrition calendars to distribute to all Head Start and Early Head Start sites.
