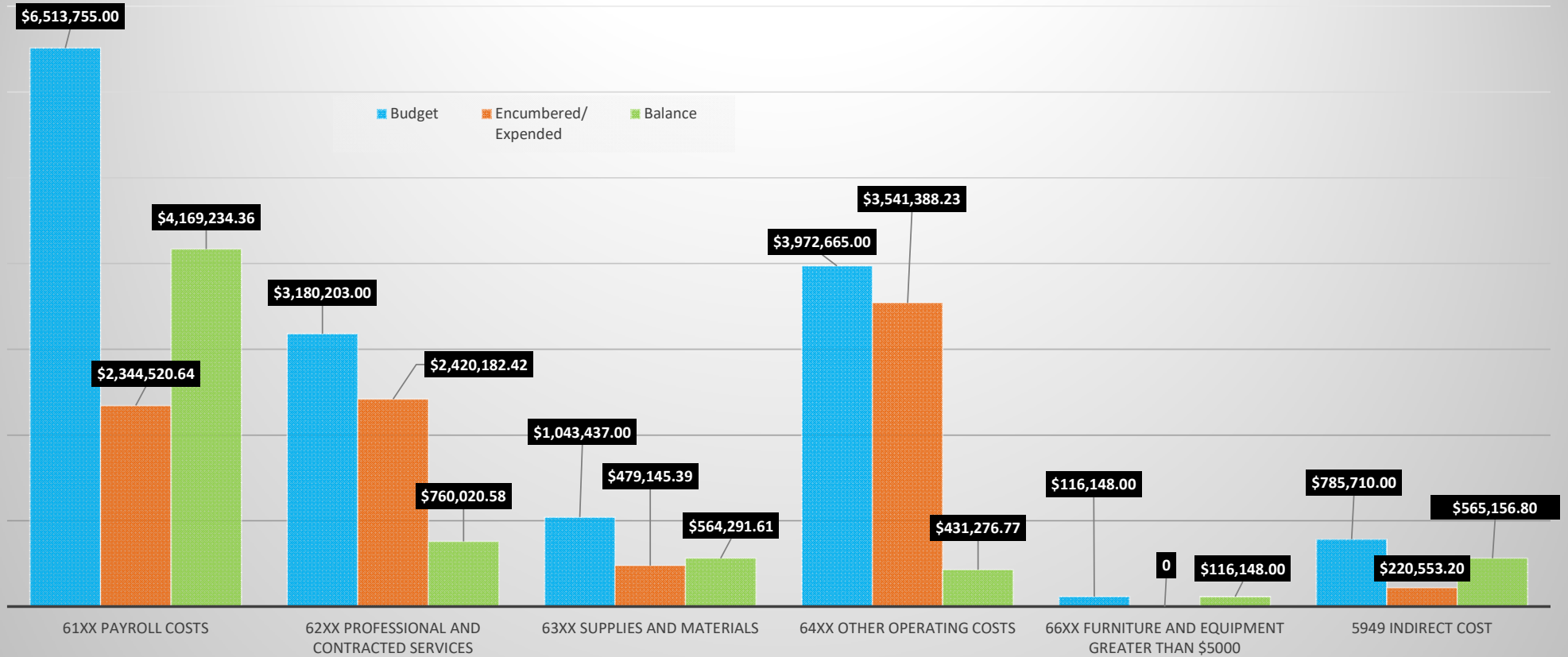


## `Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<b>Early Head Start Education:</b> Completed Conscious Discipline Executive Skills training for 8 Early Head Start directors/teachers; completed new teacher training for Communication/Literacy for 21 Early Head Start teachers/directors; finalized developmental Fall checkpoints for all Early Head Start students; completed 1 <sup>st</sup> parent conferences		
<b>Head Start Education:</b> Provided training for 67 teachers and 67 instructional assistants through “The Coffee Shop Chat” newsletter; conducted Classroom Assessment Scoring System observations for 8 teachers		
<b>Family Services:</b> Finalized Family Services Credential for 11 staff; delivered training regarding formal meeting procedures to 3 Policy Council Officers; assisted Policy Council Officers in the facilitation of the November Policy Council meeting for 8 parents and 1 community representative; provided a Family Services overview training to Policy Council members; obtained names of 18 children from regional sites who will benefit from being on the Region 16 Angel Tree; connected 71 local children with Christmas assistance; connected 57 children with warm coats.		
<b>Health:</b> Performed dental exams on 250 Head Start students, assessed hemoglobin and lead levels of 190 Head Start students, scheduled 27 Head Start and Early Head Start students for specialist appointments for hearing and vision exams; attended 2 medical appointments with a Head Start family.		
<b>Mental Wellness:</b> Provided in-person support at 12 locations, with multiple other contacts by phone and email; distributed through teachers a mental wellness tip link (English and Spanish) for families being served virtually.		
<b>Nutrition:</b> Assisted food service staff at Nelson for 2 weeks; coordinated with 6 sites in-person and multiple sites virtually to provide nutrition assistance; developed nutrition overview for Health Advisory Committee.
