Early Head Start Education: Concluded Infant/Toddler Environmental Rating Scale-3 (ITERS-3) observations for 12 teachers; shared Infant/Toddler Environmental Rating Scale-3 (ITERS-3) scores and provided feedback with teachers and directors of all completed observations; provided program updates and training through Directors's Meeting for 21 Early Head Start directors and staff; began sending out resources and training for upcoming Conscious Discipline parenting mini-session-5 sites delivered so far.

Head Start Education: All Head Start teachers began the Children's Learning Institute assessment on the students in their classrooms; Education Specialists provided cluster training for 40 Instructional Assistants; Education Coordinator and 5 Education Specialists attended the Texas Association for Education of Young Children in Galveston.

Family Services: Met with Panhandle Community Services to plan an event for Early Head Start/Head Start families to receive utility assistance; trained 48 family services staff to present Conscious Discipline mini-sessions; attended the Texas Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers' virtual conference by three family services specialists; facilitated officer elections and assisted the newly-elected ChairPerson in leading Policy Council for 10 representatives.

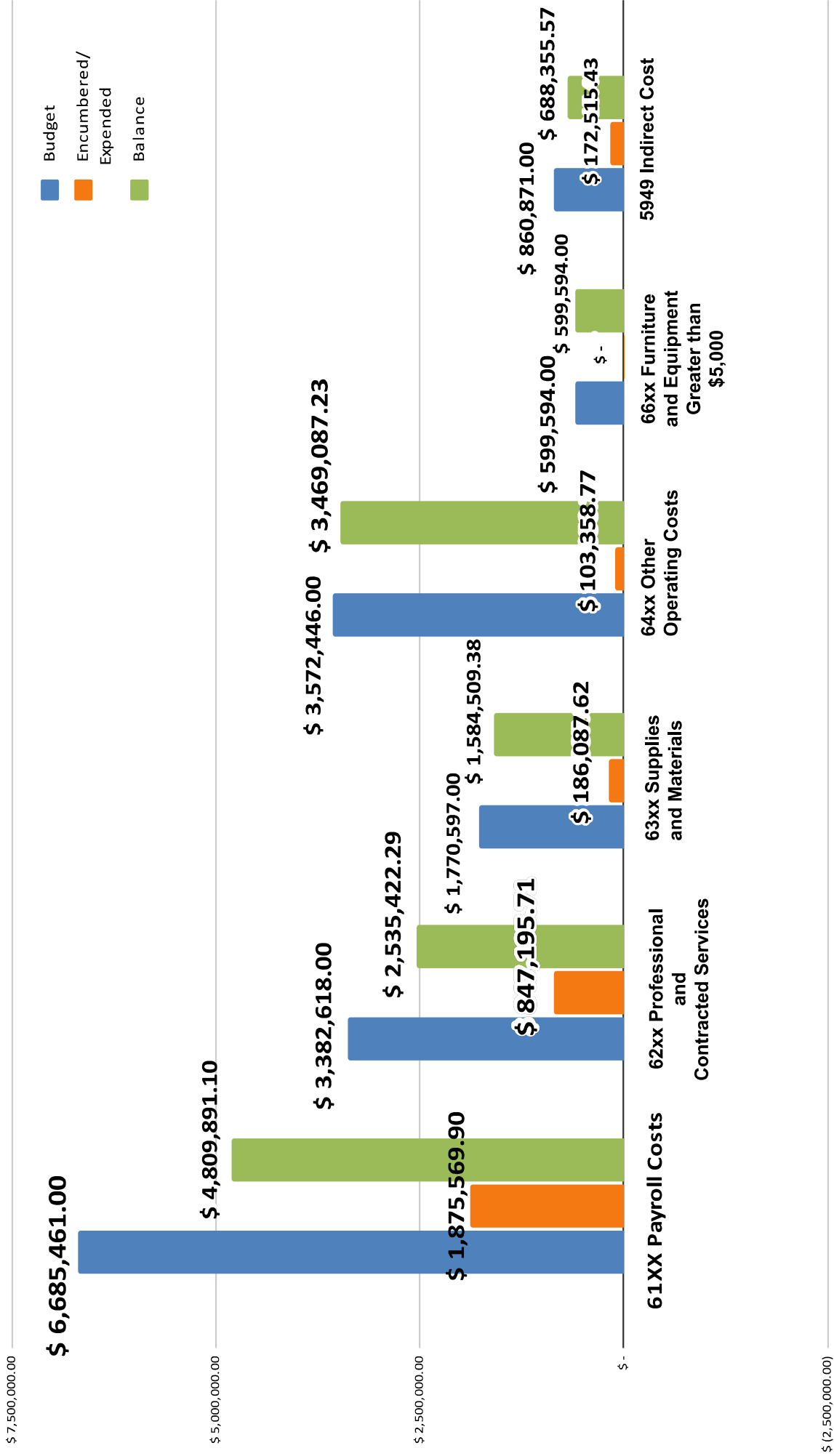
Health: Participated in precepting 6 Amarillo College nursing students; assisted in conducting dental exams for 367 Head Start children and 7 Early Head Start children; conducted health screenings for 46 Early Head Start Children and 661 Head Start children; conducted Health Advisory Committee meeting.

Mental Wellness: Presented "Conscious Discipline Parenting Kickoff" training for 5 parents in Farwell; provided training in "The Trauma Lens & Challenging Behavior" and "Secondary Trauma & Self-Care" to 40 instructional assistants during cluster trainings.

Nutrition: Completed height and weight screenings for 49 Head Start and 26 Early Head Start students; provided nutrition updates for Health Advisory Committee members; trained 9 Early Head Start staff members to complete Meal Production Records
