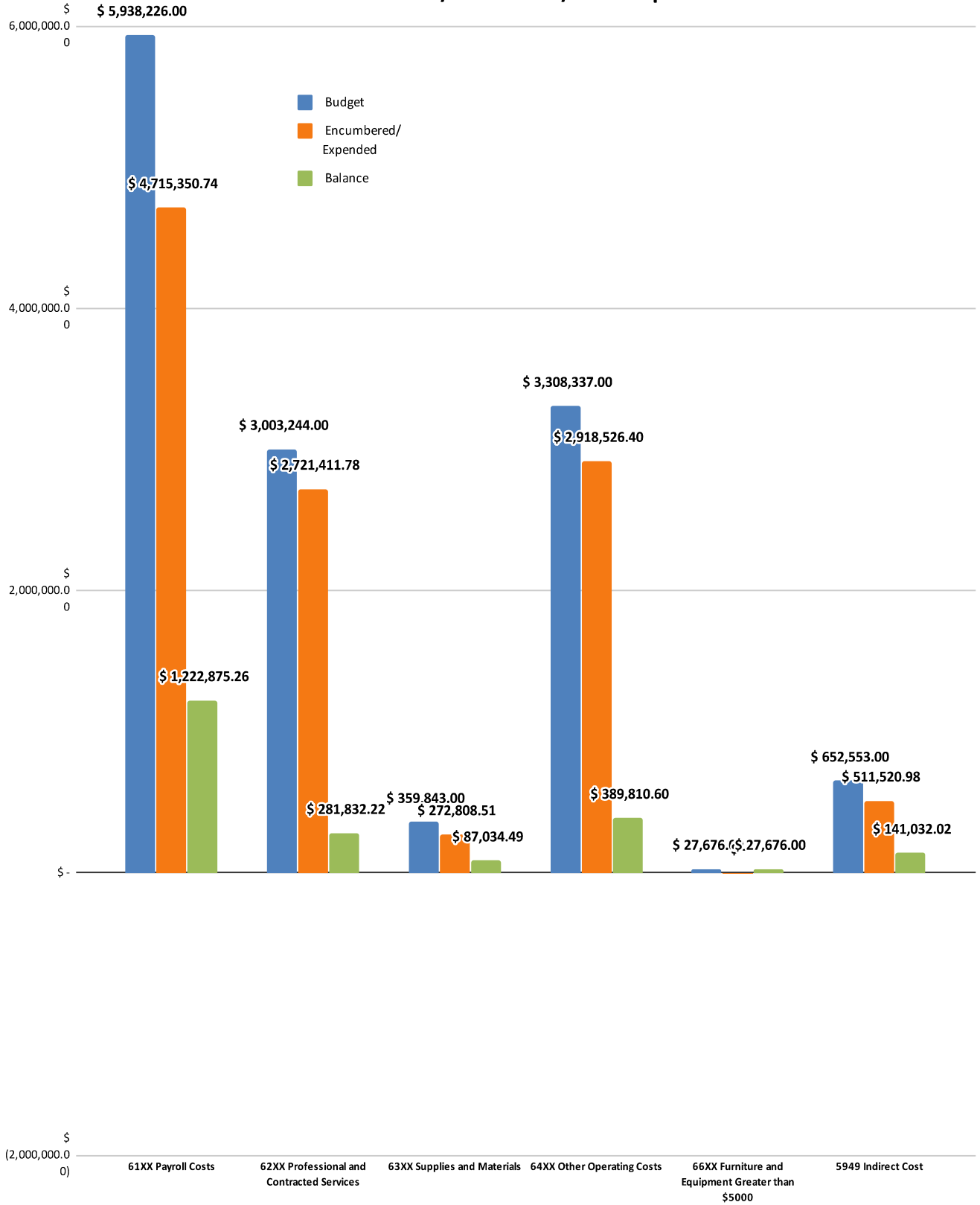


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<p>Early Head Start Education: Provided responsive care professional development for 38 Early Head Start center-based staff; provided responsive environment professional development for 32 Early Head Start center-based staff; facilitated 2 center-based directors' meetings for 9 Early Head Start Directors; provided center-based staff with access to online professional development classes through the ECLKC Head Start web site; created and provided all Early Head Start staff with Conscious Discipline newsletter.</p>		
<p>Head Start Education: Conducted weekly PLC's with 49 regional teachers; wrote 2 new policies (napping and playground use); sent annual consumable lists to all Head Start teachers; assisted 49 regional teachers to plan for virtual home visits.</p>		
<p>Family Services: Attended Parents As Teachers virtual Leadership Summit; required 15 HB staff to view Conscious Discipline's webinar: "COVID-19 Stress: How Uncertainty Affects Our Brains"; provided 369 caregivers with family activities for the home, Conscious Discipline information, and community resource information.</p>		
<p>Health: Provided prenatal and postpartum education to 10 pregnant and postpartum women; documented immunization records and medical records into Child Plus; contacted 20 parents regarding medical appointments for vision, dental, and developmental pediatrician appointments.</p>		
<p>Mental Wellness: Researched and provided links, articles, videos, and training opportunities to Head Start teachers and Early Head Start home educators on a weekly basis (for staff and to share with parents); provided weekly "Wellness Wednesday" email to parents at Cleveland and Nelson Street campuses; appeared at teacher PLC online meetings to offer reminders and verbal support.</p>		
<p>Nutrition: Updated CACFP on-line training; assisted with removal of items at Cleveland and Nelson kitchens to prepare for new food management company; documented final nutrition referrals and results in Child Plus; contacted 17 classroom and Family Services staff regarding nutrition concerns.</p>
