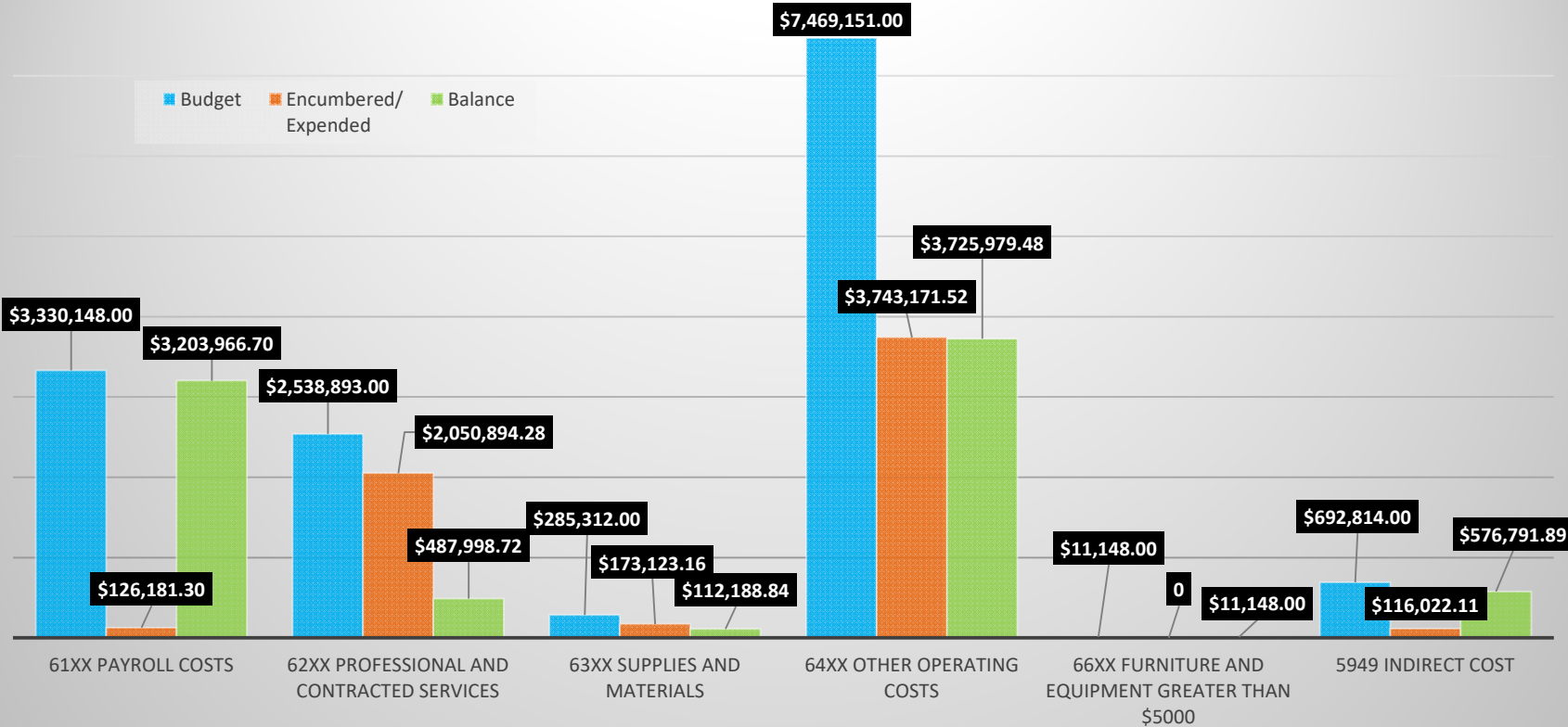


## Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<p><b>Early Head Start Education:</b> Completed Trauma Informed Conscious Discipline for 93 Early Head Start staff; provided online Conscious Discipline Parenting Curriculum Mini-Session training for all center-based and home-based early head start teachers; provided Engaging Infant and Toddlers training for 93 Early Head Start staff; finalized summer checkpoints in Teaching Strategies Gold Assessment; completed 1<sup>st</sup> Educational Home Visits for center-based children</p>		
<p><b>Head Start Education:</b> Completed training concerning Best Practices, home visits, Environmental Checklist for the classroom, curriculum, and lesson planning; Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS), ChildPlus, and Children’s Learning Institute (CLI);</p>		
<p><b>Family Services:</b> Completed Family Services Managers Institute offered by the National Center on Parent, Family, and Community Engagement by 3 Family Services Specialists; provided training to 55 family services staff regarding family engagement, the Family Partnership Agreement, and being poverty-informed; provided training to 6 new family services staff regarding Child Plus, building relationships, home visits, and monthly duties; Facilitated EduHero training for 62 family services staff members.</p>		
<p><b>Health:</b> Conducted a health intake for 14 EHS and HS students at opportunity school; performed health screenings on 70 EHS students; provided trainings about wearing masks to Cleveland and Nelson staff; presented health training to regional FSAs on Zoom.</p>		
<p><b>Mental Wellness:</b> Completed and presented Zoom training to Cleveland EHS staff about developmental and social-emotional screening instruments and communicating with parents; completed research and planning for HS screening instruments for students opting for virtual services; provided links/handouts to HS teachers including COVID-19 Support Line, Wearing Masks Tip sheet, Wearing Masks Social Story, and Self-Care Strategies for Educators.</p>		
<p><b>Nutrition:</b> Presented Zoom training to all FSA’s regarding documentation and screenings for nutrition; Presented CACFP annual training via Zoom to Cleveland/Nelson staff; Provided meal count updates to 53 Cleveland/Nelson classroom staff; Assisted with initial screening for 51 EHS children at 5 sites.</p>
