Early Head Start Education: Completed Infant/Toddler Environmental Rating Scale-3 (ITERS-3) observations for 60 teachers; shared Infant/Toddler Environmental Rating Scale-3 (ITERS-3) scores and provided feedback with teachers and directors of all completed observations; created new intentional lesson plan template

Head Start Education: Provided face to face training for 7 new classroom instructional assistants; provided face to face training for 26 teachers for the Classroom Assessment Scoring System

Family Services: Provided training over required first of year tasks to 12 new family services staff; facilitated Community Partner Program training for 26 family services staff; trained 10 parents and 19 staff over the importance of parent leadership and how to have successful parent meetings; hosted car seat safety events at 3 sites; recruited parents to be Policy Council representatives.

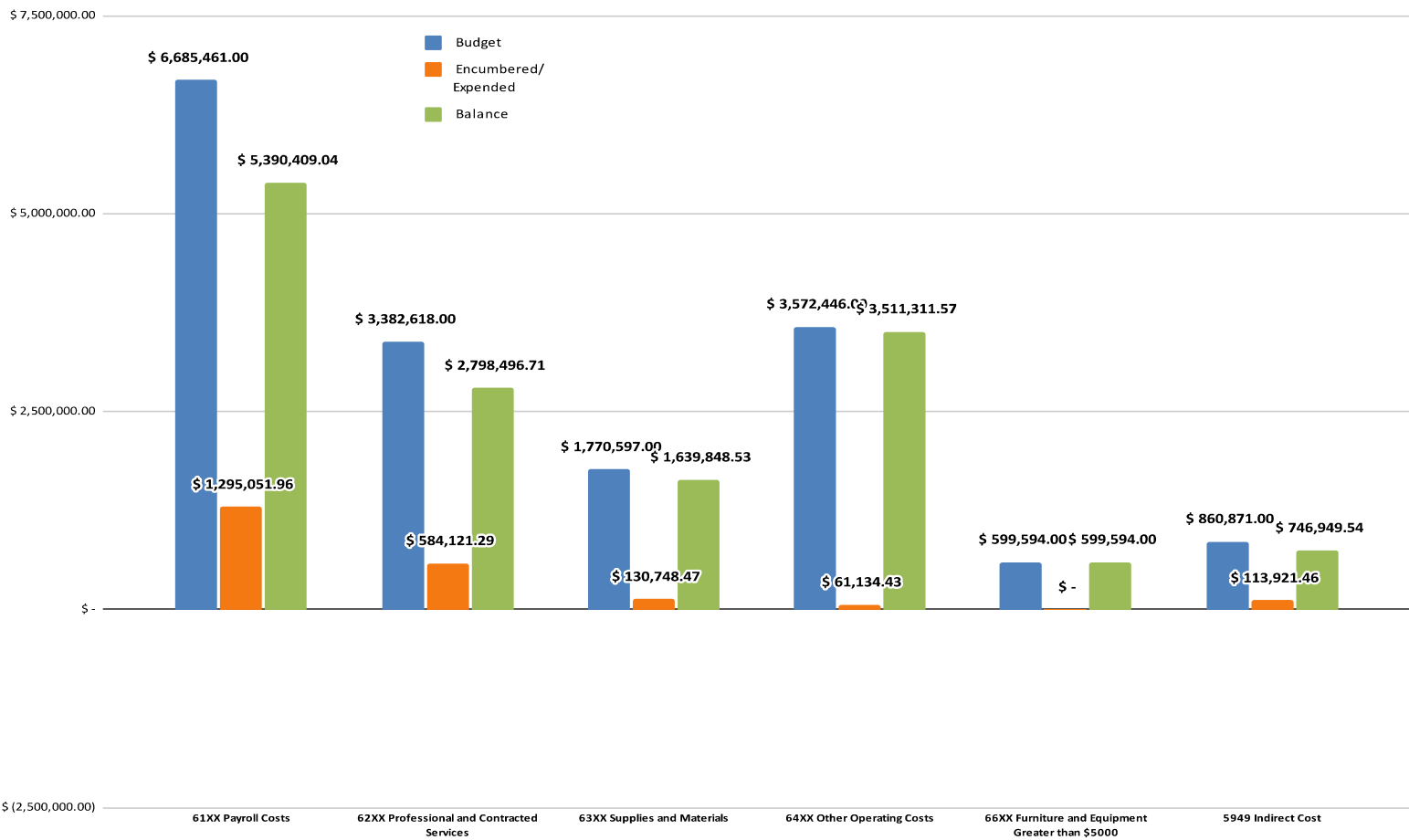
Health: Attended 2 specialist appointments with Head Start families; provided education on communicable disease to 46 Early Head Start families; assisted in conducting dental exams for 460 Head Start children and 166 Early Head Start children; completed screenings for 40 Early Head Start children and 956 Head Start children.

Mental Wellness: Presented "Conscious Discipline Parenting Kick-Off" to 21 parents in Perryton meeting and 7 parents in Wellington meeting; conducted routine site visits and individual observation requests at numerous sites.

Nutrition: Completed initial heights and weights for 1004 HS and 48 EHS children. Monitored Cleveland and Nelson Centers for CACFP compliance.
