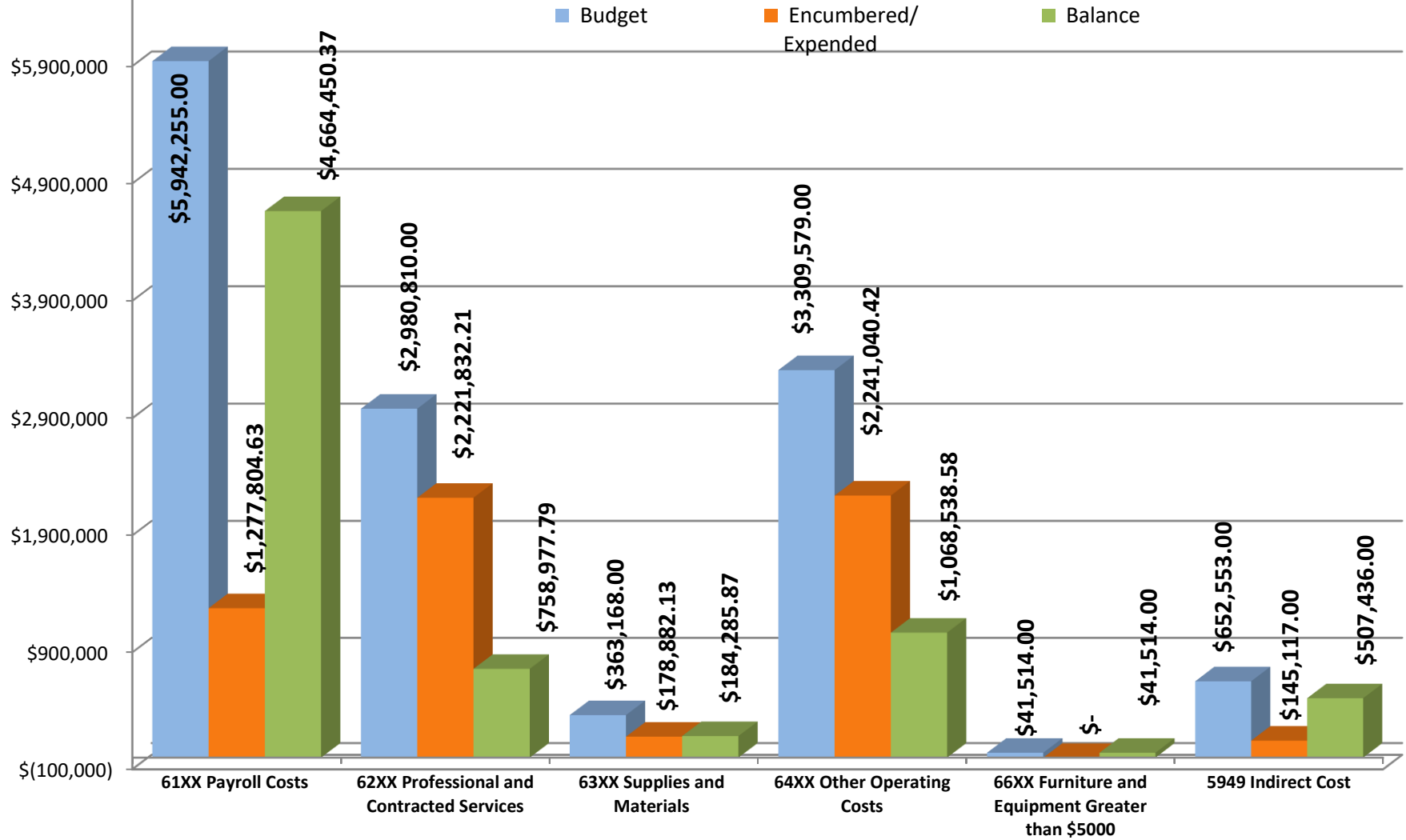


## Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

<p><b>Early Head Start Education:</b> Completed Conscious Discipline Parenting Curriculum mini session trainings for 57 EHS teachers; completed Infant Toddler Environmental Rating Scale-3 (ITERS-3) overview training for 62 EHS teachers and instructional assistants/subs, 1 director, and 1 FSA; completed disability training for 6 EHS teachers and 1 director; completed focused observation training for 6 EHS teachers and 1 director</p>		
<p><b>Head Start Education:</b> Assisted 10 teachers with the Brigance Developmental Screener; trained 15 new instructional assistants; trained 14 new teachers on the CLASS instrument; 63 teachers began the CLI assessment.</p>		
<p><b>Family Services:</b> Hire/train 2 interpreters; provided Conscious Discipline Kick Off Parent Meeting at 23 Head Start sites; elected parent officers and formed Parent Committees; continued to initiate Family Partnership Agreements with Head Start families.</p>		
<p><b>Health:</b> Performed dental exams for over 400 children in Head Start and EHS; conducted 750 vision, hearing, and dental screens for HS and EHS throughout the region; attended 2 appointments to the Developmental Pediatrician with HS families; made 10 appointments to specialist for failed vision and hearing screenings; conducted pregnancy assessments on 12 women.</p>		
<p><b>Mental Wellness:</b> Provided site visits and consultation to most sites in the panhandle; assisted with presenting "Conscious Discipline" to parent groups for initial meeting; provided technical assistance for Brigance Self-Help &amp; Social Emotional Scales.</p>		
<p><b>Nutrition:</b> Completed initial growth assessments for 756 HS and 59 EHS children; monitored Cleveland and Nelson kitchens for CACFP compliance.</p>		
<p><i>USDA Meal Counts: (August)</i> Breakfast 11,546; Lunch 12,767; Snack 6,094</p>
