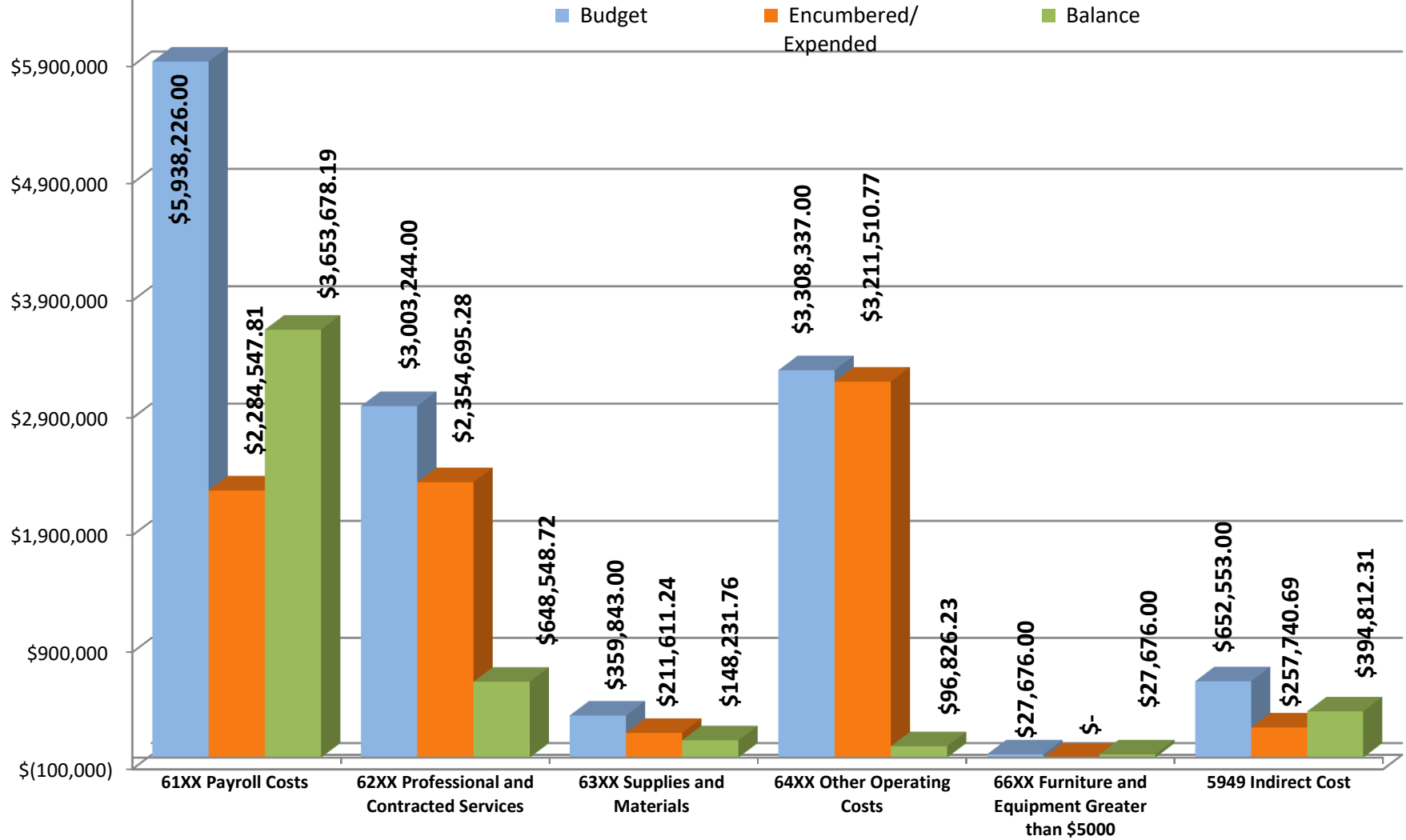


Head Start/Early Head Start Program Monthly Program Summary

Family Services: Provided training to 3 Policy Council officers regarding meeting protocol and procedures; trained 11 Family Service Staff to provide Conscious Discipline Mini-Sessions to parents; received training from WTAMU's Annual Ethics Conference for 2 Family Service Specialists; facilitated Policy Council meeting for 6 Parent Representatives and 4 Community Representatives.		
Health: Attended Stop Bleed training at Bell street; performed health screenings on 31 EHS children and 45 HS children; attended 5 Developmental Pediatrician appointments with HS children and families; assisted 1 pregnant woman with High Risk Pregnancy referrals; assessed 4 Pregnant women.		
Mental Wellness: Conducted follow-up for missing or incomplete Brigance screening data; attended Counselor's Quarterly Updates/Networking meeting; conducted routine site visits and observations.		
Nutrition: Provided CACFP training for 7 kitchen and 9 administrative staff members; trained 11 EHS directors and 7 new EHS teachers on nutrition requirements; prepared for CACFP review.
