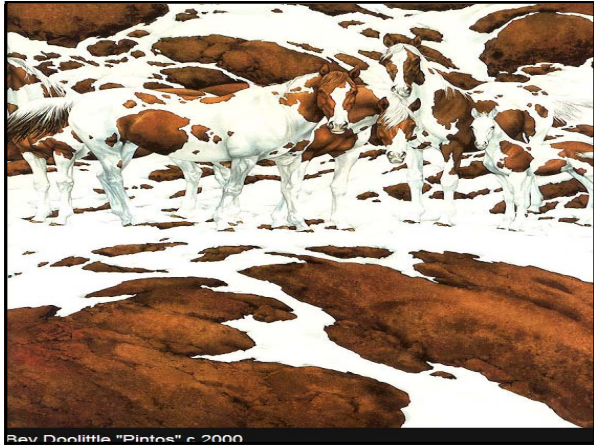


Comprehension Builders

These are strategies great readers use!





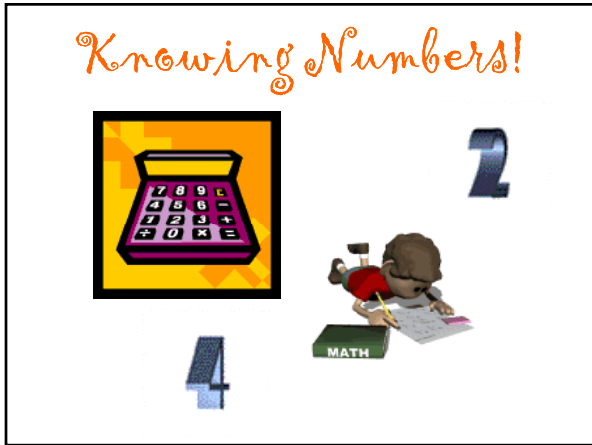

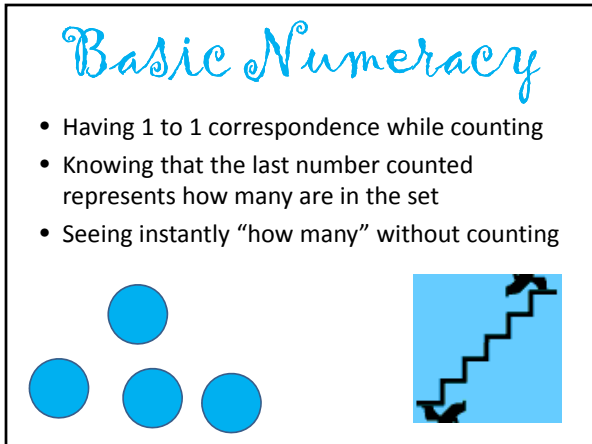
