What is included in TexQuest?

- Magazine, newspaper, encyclopedia, academic journal, and reference book articles with citations – easily searched and shared
- Full text eBooks and magazines with simultaneous access
- Copyright safe images, videos, and audio files
- Rich primary sources materials to support TEKS and new SAT
- Features like text-to-speech, translate, TEK and lexile search

Where is information on how to use TexQuest?

Which districts are participating?

What is the cost?

Because TexQuest is supported by the Texas State Legislature, districts will be assessed an annual participation fee of only 25 cents per pupil, based on October enrollment data provided by TEA. TexQuest participation is only available at the district level.
