

## August 2021 ESSA Pandemic Waiver Approvals

Two ESSA waivers have been approved by USDE that are reflected below:

1. Extending the period of availability of ESSA 2019-2020 funds (that would have otherwise ended 9/30/2021) to end 9/30/2022.
2. Waiving the requirement for a statutory waiver in order for the LEA to be allowed to exceed the Title I, Part A 15% carryover limitation.

<sup>2</sup> Title I, Part A carryover waiver requirement has been waived by USDE, effectively allowing more than 15% to be carried forward into 2021-2022

Note there is no need for a carryover waiver for other ESSA programs since they do not have statutory limitations similar to Title I, Part A statute.
